SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 6 1/2 x 34 in. (16.5 x 86.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 136-305 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Glacier Bay Tweed
1 Ball
 - Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
 - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- *Heartland (Article #136). Solids: 100% Acrylic
Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon;
package size: Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)
Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*



GAUGE:

21 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Drop St Pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES:

Scarfie is worked in one piece in an easy Drop st pattern.

SCARFIE

Cast on 32 sts.

Knit 3 rows for beginning border.

Drop St Pattern

Set up Row (RS): K3 *p2, k1, yo, k1, p2, k2; rep from * to last 5 sts, p2, k3 – you will have 35 sts at the end of this row.

Rows 1, 3 and 5: K2, p1, *k2, p2, k2, p3; rep from * to last 5 sts, k2, p1, k2.

Rows 2 and 4: K3, *p2, k3, p2, k2; rep from * to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

Row 6: K3, *p2, k1, drop next st from left hand needle and let it unravel down to the yo from 6 rows below; k1, p2, k1, yo, k1; rep from * to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

Rows 7, 9 and 11: K2, p1, *k2, p3, k2, p2; rep from * to last 5 sts, k2, p1, k2.

Rows 8 and 10: K3, *p2, k2, p2, k3; rep from * to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

Row 12: K3, *p2, k1, yo, k1, p2, k1, drop next st from left hand needle and let it unravel down to the yo from 6 rows below; k1; rep from * to last 5 sts, p2, k3.

Rep Rows 1-12 until piece measures about 33 in. (84 cm) from beg, end with a Row 11 as the last row you work.

Next Row: K3, *p2, k2, p2, k1, drop next st from left hand needle and let it unravel down to the yo from 6 rows below; k1; rep from * to last 5 sts, p2, k3 – 32 sts.

Knit 3 rows for ending border.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
