#### **MATERIALS**

- 640-512 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Monarch  
3 Balls (A)
  - 640-514 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Blue Jay  
3 Balls (B)
  - 640-510 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Toucan  
3 Balls (C)
  - 640-511 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Parakeet  
3 Balls (D)
  - Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
  - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- \*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon; Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon; Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### **GAUGE:**

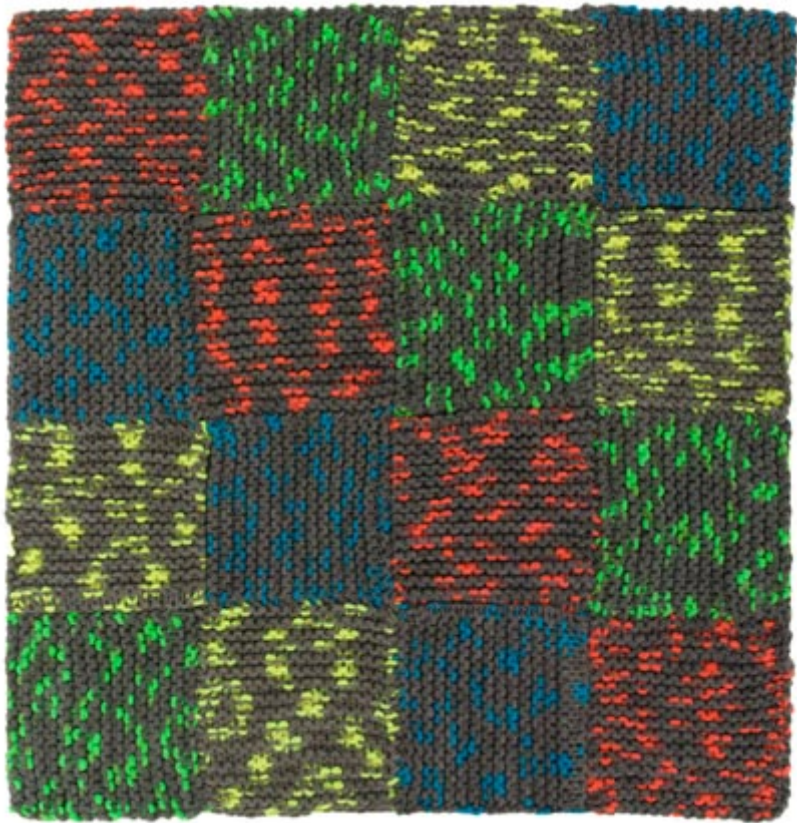
One Block = about 9 x 9 in. (23 x 23 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

1. 16 Blocks are worked in Garter st (knit every row), then sewn together following a diagram.
2. For visual interest, directions of the Blocks alternates – just follow the diagram!



**BLOCKS (make 16: 4 each with A, B, C, and D)**

Cast on 18 sts.

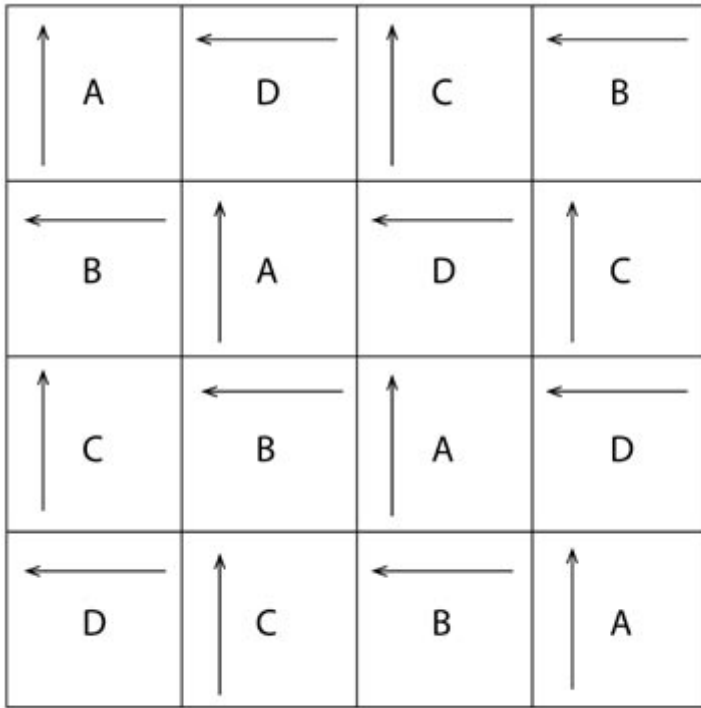
Work in Garter st (knit every row) for 32 rows.

Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Following diagram, sew Blocks into 4 strips of 4 Blocks each, alternating direction of knitting as shown on diagram. Sew strips together to make Blanket.

Weave in ends.
