**HAT** 

**Finished Circumference** About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes. **Finished Length** About 7 1/2 in. (19 cm), not including earflaps **SCARF** 

About 4 1/2 x 48 in. (11.5 x 122 cm)

# **GAUGE:**

8 sc = 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

# **NOTES:**

- 1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round.
- 2. Earflaps and front flap are worked directly onto lower edge of Hat.
- 3. Materials are sufficient for both Hat and Scarf. If you plan to make both, work the Hat first so that you have sufficient A yarn for the Hat.

4. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Carry color not in use along side of piece until next needed.

# **HAT**

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, turn, work 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 14 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, turn, \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc – 21 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, turn, \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc – 28 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, turn, \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* 5 more times, sc to end of rnd; join with sl st in first sc – 34 sc.

**Rnd 6:** Rep Rnd 5 – 40 sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rep Rnd 7 until piece measures about 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) from beg.

**Note:** Work now proceeds back and forth in rows.

Next Row (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in next 26 sts; leave rem 14 sts unworked for front of Hat.

#### Left Earflap

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts; leave remaining 15 sts unworked for back of Hat and right earflap – you will have 10 sts for left earflap at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog - 8 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Rows 4-7:** Rep Rows 2 and 3 – 4 sts rem.

Fasten off.

# Right Earflap

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, skip first 5 unworked sts following first earflap, join A with sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st – 10 sts for right earflap.

Rows 2-7: Rep Rows 2-7 of left earflap.

Fasten off.

#### **Edging for Earflaps and Back**

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join B with sl st in sp at beg of left earflap, work sc evenly spaced around edge of earflap, sc in each of 5 sts across back of Hat, sc evenly spaced around edge of right earflap.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sl st in each sc around Hat and earflaps. Fasten off.

# Front Flap

From RS, join A with sl st at front of Hat, ready to work across 14 sts of front of Hat, sl st in each st across.

Row 1 (WS of Hat, RS of front flap): Ch 1, turn, working through back loops only, sc in each of 14 sts across front of Hat.

Rows 2-7: Ch 1, turn, working through both loops, sc in each st across.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st – 12 sts. Fasten off.

# Front Flap Edging

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS of front flap, join B with sl st at beg of flap; ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around edge of flap, working 2 sc in each corner.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, working through front loops only, sl st in each st of flap edging. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Fold Front Flap up against Hat and sew top corners of Flap to Hat.

# Ties (make 2)

Cut a 2 yd. (2 m) strand of A. With crochet hook, draw strand through lower edge of one earflap, drawing out ends evenly. With both ends of strand held together, chain for desired length (our ties measured about 13 in. (33 cm). Fasten off.

Rep for other earflap. Weave in ends.

# **SCARF**

With B, ch 10.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end – 9 sc.

Rows 2-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across, changing to A in last st.

Row 9: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 10: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across, changing to B in last st.

Row 11: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 12: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across, changing to A in last st.

Rows 13-80: Rep Rows 9-12.

Rows 81 and 82: Rep Rows 9 and 10.

Fasten off A.

Rows 83-90: With B, rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
