MATERIALS

- 860-173 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Green](#)
1 Ball (A)
- 860-126 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Chocolate](#)
1 Ball (B)
- 860-100 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: White](#)
1 Ball (C)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 \(4 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic
400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)
Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)
Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*



GAUGE:

14 hdc = 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

BOOTIES (make 2)

Ch 11.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to last ch, 5 sc in last ch; turn piece to work across opposite side of foundation ch; sc in next 8 ch, 2 sc in last ch; join with a sl st in first sc – you will have 24 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st in this rnd or in any of the following rnds), hdc in same sp as joining, hdc in

next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next 2 sts; join with a sl st in first st – 32 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in same sp as joining, hdc in next 12 sts, 2 hdc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 12 sts, 2 hdc in next 2 sts, hdc again in same sp as first hdc; join with a sl st in first hdc – 38 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, working through back loops only, hdc in each st around; join with a sl st in first st.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, working through both loops, rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in next 10 sts, (hdc2tog) 7 times, hdc in next 14 sts; join with a sl st in first sc – 31 sts.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in next 9 sts, (hdc2tog) 4 times, hdc in next 14 sts; join with a sl st in first st – 27 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in next 9 sts, (hdc2tog) twice, sc in next 14 sts; join with a sl st in first st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Football (make 2)

With B, ch 12.

Rnd 1: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook, *sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, tr in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, sc in next ch, sl st in last ch; turn to work across opposite side of foundation ch; sl st in first ch; rep from * across; join with a sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off leaving a long yarn tail.

With C, embroider straight st lines on Football. With yarn tail, sew Football to front of Bootie.

Weave in ends.
