MATERIALS

- 924-113 Lion Brand Modern Baby: Red
1 Ball (A) **Modern Baby (Article #924). 50% Acrylic, 50% Nylon; package size: 2.60oz/75.00 gr. (173yds/158m) pull skeins*
- 924-149 Lion Brand Modern Baby: Grey
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

8 Shells + 13 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Shell (1 sc and 1 dc) worked into indicated st.

NOTES:

1. Cozy is worked in joined rnds beg at bottom of Cozy.
2. The first rnd is formed by working into the foundation chains and then working into the back bumps across the opposite side of the foundation chain (the back bumps are at the bottom of the sts just worked). To complete the first rnd, the last sc is joined to the first sc with a sl st.
3. The shell pattern is started in Rnd 2. To begin, work the first shell into the same st as the sl st that was used to join Rnd 1, then continue around alternately skipping one st and working a shell into the next st. At the end of the rnd, join the last shell to the first with a sl st.
4. In Rnd 3 and all following rnds beg by turning to work back in the opposite direction. Turning at the beginning of rnds is needed to continue the shell pattern properly. Work the first shell into the

same st as the sl st that was used to join the previous rnd. Since the work was turned, this means you will need to angle your hook backwards a little bit to reach the joining st.

5. The shell pattern can be worked for the number of rnds indicated in the pattern or until the Cozy is as tall as desired. Then work Rnd 18 and fasten off.

COZY

With larger hook and A, ch 13.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 10 ch, 3 sc in last ch.

Working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 10 ch, 2 sc in last ch; join with a sl st in first sc – you will have 26 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, do not turn, work (sc, dc) in same sp as joining (first Shell made), *sk next st, Shell in next st; rep from * to last st; sk last st, join with sl st in first st – 13 Shells at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, turn, Shell in same sp as joining, *sk next st, Shell in next st; repeat from * to last st, sk last st; join with a sl st in first st.

Rnds 4-17: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, turn, Shell in same sp as joining, *sk next st, Shell in next st; rep from * 3 more times, ch 20 (for button loop), *sk 1 st, Shell in next st; rep from * to last st, sk last st; join with a sl st in first st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Heart Button (make 2)

With smaller hook and B, ch 3; join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring; join with a sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 6 dc in same sp as joining, sc in next 3 sts, 3 dc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 6 dc in next st, ch 2, sl st in last st.

Fasten off.

Sew Heart Buttons together around outside edge. Sew button to Cozy, opposite button loop.

Weave in ends.
