# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Modern Baby<sup>®</sup> Valentine's Day Gift Bag

Pattern Number: L40733

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

About 4 x 4 1/2 in. (10 x 11.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 31, 2015)

## **GIFT BAG**

With larger hook and A, ch 13.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, and in next 9 ch, 3 sc in last ch.

Working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 9 ch, 2 sc in last ch; join with a slip st in first sc  $-\frac{26}{24}$  sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), dc in each st around; join with a slip st in top of first dc – 26 24 dc.

\*Modern Baby (Article #924). 50% Acrylic, 50%

Nylon; package size: 2.60oz/75.00 gr.

(173yds/158m) pull skeins

## MATERIALS

- 924-113 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Modern Baby: Red</u> 1 Ball (A)
- 924-098 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Modern Baby: Cream</u> 1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet <u>Hook - Size H-8 (5</u> <u>mm)</u>
- Lion Brand Crochet <u>Hook - Size G-6 (4</u> <u>mm)</u>
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of <u>6)</u>

# GAUGE:

14 dc + 8 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

1. Gift Bag is worked in joined rounds. Do not turn at end of rounds.

Modern Baby

- 2. Heart is worked separately and sewed to completed Gift Bag.
- 3. Materials are sufficient to make multiple Gift Bags.

## **GIFT BAG**

With larger hook and A, ch 13.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, and in next 9 ch, 3 sc in last ch.

Working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 9 ch, 2 sc in last ch; join with a slip st in first sc – 24 sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), dc in each st around; join with a slip st in top of first dc – 24 dc. **Rnds 3-7:** Repeat Rnd 2.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 3 (counts as dc, ch1), skip next st, dc in next st, \*ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st; repeat from \* to end of rnd; join with a slip st in 2nd ch of beginning ch 3.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, sc in each st and ch to end of rnd. Fasten off.

# FINISHING

#### Drawstring

Cut 2 yds. (2 m) of B.

Hold cut strand together with strand of B from ball.

With smaller hook and these 2 strands of B held together, ch 50.

Fasten off.

Weave drawstring in and out of the spaces on Rnd 8 of Gift Bag.

## Heart

With smaller hook and B, ch 3.

SI st in first ch to make a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 2 (counts as first dc), work 9 dc into ring; join with a slip st in first dc – you will have 10 dc at the end of this round.

**Round 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), work 6 dc in same space as joining, sc in next 3 sts, 3 dc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 6 dc in next st, ch 2; join with a slip st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

With yarn tail, sew heart to Gift Bag.

Weave in yarn ends.
