

# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Kitchen Cotton Warm Heart Cup Cozy

**SKILL LEVEL**: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

About 3 x 9 in. (7.5 x 23 cm), to fit a standard coffee or tea cup

 831-113 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Kitchen Cotton Yarn: Hot</u>

<u>Pepper</u>

1 Ball (A)

<u>Vanilla</u>

1 Ball (B)

<u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
 <u>Hook - Size H-8 (5 mm)</u>

<u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u>

\*<u>Kitchen Cotton</u> (Article #831). 100% Cotton; package size: 2.00oz/57.00 gr. (99yds/90m) pull skeins



## **GAUGE:**

14 hdc + 10 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# **NOTES:**

- 1. Cozy is worked in one piece in the round in your choice of color.
- 2. Heart is made separately, then sewn to Cozy.
- 3. Yarn amount is sufficient to make 4-5 Cozies.

### COZY

With A or B, ch 30.

Slip st in beginning ch to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each ch around.

Join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – you will have 30 hdc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st around, join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2. Repeat Rnd 2 until piece measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from beginning.

Fasten off.

#### **HEART**

With B, ch 3, slip st in first ch to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 9 dc into ring.

Join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – you will have 10 dc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), work 6 dc in same space as joining, sc into each of next 3 sts, work 3 dc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, work 6 dc in next st, ch 2, sl st in last st.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

#### **FINISHING**

With yarn tail, sew Heart to Cozy. Weave in ends.
