### MATERIALS

- 640-133 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Pumpkin](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 640-112 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Raspberry](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- 640-146 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Fig](#)  
1 Ball (C)

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640).  
Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool  
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon  
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon  
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)  
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)  
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



### GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

### NOTES:

1. Arm knitting is a fun, fast technique that creates a wonderfully open fabric using only your arms! The openness of the fabric can be altered by how tight or loose you choose to make your stitches.
2. The Cowl is arm knit as a simple rectangle with 3 strands of yarn held together.

### COWL

With 1 strand each of A, B and C (3 strands total), cast on 10 stitches following Lion Brand Yarn video instructions, "How To Arm Knit":

Arm knit until about 40 in. (101.5 cm) of yarn remains.  
Bind off.

### FINISHING

Hold the ends of the piece together and with your fingers weave yarn tail in and out through the ends to join them. Then weave yarn tail through stitches to hide the tail.
