MATERIALS

**Unique (Article #755). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (109yds/100m) pull skeins*

- 755-209 [Lion Brand Unique Yarn: Cornucopia](#)
2 Balls
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 \[5.5 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



GAUGE:

15 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. Two Squares are worked, then sewn together to make Hat.
2. Top of Hat is gathered.

SQUARES (make 2)

Cast on 34 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beginning.



Bind off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Step 1

Following the diagram, sew Squares together to make a ring – the lines on the diagram show the direction of the rows of knitting, the Squares are turned in different directions.

STEP 1





Step 2

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle. Following diagram, weave needle in and out of one edge of Hat. Pull yarn to gather, then knot.

Weave in ends.
