Cabled Heart Boot Cuff

Pattern Number: L40737

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 10 in. (25.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished Length About 6 in. (15 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 18, 2015)

CUFFS (make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 56 sts.

Row 1: K1, *k2, p2, rep from * to last st, k last st **across**.

Row 2: K1, k the knit sts and p the purl sts to last st, knit last st. **Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts.**

Begin Heart Cables

Row 16: K1, p1, *1/2RPC **2/1 RPC**, p2, 2/2RC, p2, 2/1LPC, p4; rep from * once more; 1/2RPC **2/1 RPC**, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, 2/1LPC, p3, k1.

Row 18: K1, *1/2RPC **2/1 RPC**, p3, k4, p3, 2/1LPC, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 24: K1, *k2, p2, rep from * to last st, k last st. ***P2, k2; rep from * across.**

MATERIALS

- 860-101 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Pink **Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm] **400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10 [6 mm] **Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)
- Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2) **Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

16 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with smaller needles.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

2/1 LPC (2 over 1 left purl cross): Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, p1, then k2 from cable needle.

2/1 RPC (2 over 1 right purl cross): Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold in back of work, k2, then p1 from cable needle.

2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

2/2 RC (2 over 2 right cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

2/2 LPC (2 over 2 left cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, p2, then k2 from cable needle.

2/2 RPC (2 over 2 right cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back of work, k2, then p2 from cable needle.

NOTES:

Cuffs are worked flat then sides are seamed.

CUFFS (make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 56 sts.

Row 1: *K2, p2, rep from * across.

Row 2: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts.

Rows 3-11: Rep Row 2.

Begin Heart Cables

Change to larger needles.

Row 12 (RS): K1, p4, *2/2RC, 2/2LC, p10; rep from * once more; 2/2RC, 2/2LC, p6, k1.

Rows 13, 15, 17, 19, 21 and 23: Rep Row 2.

Row 14: K1, p2, *2/2RPC, k4, 2/2LPC, p6; rep from * once more; 2/2RPC, k4, 2/2LPC, p4, k1.

Row 16: K1, p1, *2/1RPC, p2, 2/2RC, p2, 2/1LPC, p4; rep from * once more; 2/1RPC, p2, 2/2 RC, p2, 2/1LPC, p3, k1.

Row 18: K1, *2/1RPC, p3, k4, p3, 2/1LPC, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 20: K1, *k2, p4, 2/2RC, p4, k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 22: K1, *2/2LPC, 2/2RC, 2/2LC, 2/2RPC, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 24: *P2, k2; rep from * across.

Rows 25-31: Rep Row 2.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew sides of piece to make Cuff.

Weave in ends.
