SIZE: One Size

Finished Width About 17 1/2 in. (44.5 cm), will stretch to fit.

Finished Length About 29 in. (73.5 cm)

• 136-180 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:

Kings Canyon 2 Balls (A)

• 136-174 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:

Joshua Tree 1 Ball (B)

• 136-105 <u>Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:</u> <u>Glacier Bay</u>

1 Ball (C)

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles</u> (Set of 6)

Additional Materials
 Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm)

*<u>Heartland</u> (Article #136). **Solids:** 100% Acrylic

Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)

Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)



GAUGE:

24 sts + 20 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in K1, p1 Rib.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of row. **Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

NOTES:

- 1. Front and Back are worked separately in K1, p1 Rib.
- 2. The Back is longer than the Front. The top portion of the Back is folded down and sewn to the top

edge of the Front to make the shoulders and collar.

3. Circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts, work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

FRONT

With A, cast on 104 sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib for 70 rows.

Continue in K1, p1 Rib, changing color as follows: With B, work for 8 rows.

With C, work for 16 rows.

With B, work for 8 rows.

With A, work for 8 rows.

Bind off.

BACK

With A, cast on 104 sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib for 152 rows.

Continue in K1, p1 Rib, changing color as follows: With B, work for 6 rows.

With C, work for 12 rows.

With B, work for 6 rows.


With A, work for 9 rows.

Bind off.


FINISHING

Assembly

Step 1: Lay Front on top of Back, with lower and side edges aligned. Extra length of Back will extend above Front. Following diagram, fold A on Back to meet A on Front and B on Back to meet B on Front.



Step 2: Sew edge of Back to top edge of Front as shown by dotted line on diagram for front seam.



Step 3: Beg at lower edge, sew side seams, leaving about 9 1/2 in. (23 cm) below front seam unsewn for armholes.

Weave in ends.
