SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 18 in. (46 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- 860-303 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Purple Mist
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size:

Solids: 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

14 sts + 28 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1.Hat is worked in one piece.
- 2.Completed piece is sewed together to make a tube, then one end of the tube is gathered to make the top of the Hat.

HAT

Leaving a long yarn tail, cast on 64 stitches.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beginning.

Bind off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Thread cast-on tail into blunt needle and sew side edges of piece together to make a tube.

Thread tail from bound-off edge into blunt needle, then sew in and out through sts of last row. Pull to gather top of hat and knot securely.

Weave in ends.
