SKILL LEVEL: [Beginner \(Level 1\)](#)

SIZE: One Size

Finished circumference About 20 1/2 in. (52 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished length About 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm)

MATERIALS

**Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester;
package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*

- 790-418 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Ambrosia](#)
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10 \[6 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



GAUGE:

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row).

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

Hat is worked in one piece using only the knit stitch and then seamed.

HAT

Cast on 62 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) until piece measures about 11 in. (28 cm) from beginning.

Bind off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then sew sides of piece together to make a ring, then sew in and out through sts along open end of Hat. Pull to gather for top of Hat and knot securely.

Weave in ends.
