- 924-147 Lion Brand Modern Baby: Purple 1 Ball (D)
- 924-158 Lion Brand
 - Modern Baby: Yellow 1 Ball (E)

GAUGE:

21 sts + 28 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd) and chart pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Cowl is worked in one piece in the round.
- 2. Cowl is worked in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd) and in stranded colorwork, changing yarn color following charts. Carry unused yarn color(s) loosely across WS of work.
- 3. When working from charts, work in St st worked in the rnd and read all chart rnds from right to left. Rep the sts shown on the charts all around each rnd of the Cowl.
- 4. When you see "- 12 sts" in the instructions, this lets you know how many sts you will have at the end of that specific rnd.
- 5. The finished Cowl is seamed so that the color design looks good both on the inside and the outside of the Cowl.

COWL

With A, cast on 168 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle, being careful not to twist sts.

Beginning Border

Rnd 1: With A, knit. Rnd 2: With A, purl.

Rnds 3 and 4: With B, rep Rnds 1 and 2. Rnds 5 and 6: With C, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Rnds 7-12: Rep Rnds 1-6.

With A. knit 2 rnds.

Chart 1

Next Rnd: Work in St st in rnds (k every rnd) following Rnd 1 of Chart 1, and rep 6 sts of Chart 28 times around

Continue to follow Chart 1 until Rnd 18 has been completed.

With A, knit 3 rnds.




Chart 2

Beg with Rnd 1, work in St st worked in rnds following Chart 2 (rep 4 sts of chart 42 times around). Rep Rnds 1-4 of chart 3 times, then rep Rnds 1 and 2 once more – 14 rnds total. With A, knit 2 rnds.








Chart 3

Beg with Rnd 1, work in St st worked in rnds following Chart 3 (rep 4 sts of chart 42 times around) until Rnd 14 has been completed.

With A, knit 2 rnds.

Chart 3





Ending Border

With H, E and A, rep Beginning Border Rnds 1-12. Bind off.

FINISHING

With A, sew cast-on edge to bound-off edge. Weave in ends.
