GAUGE:

1 Square = about 8 x 8 in. (20.5 x 20.5 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Cl (cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook), *yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook; rep from * once more, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

NOTES:

1. 35 Squares are worked individually in multiple stitch patterns and colors, then sewn together following a diagram to make Afghan.
2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.



SQUARE 1 (make 6)

With B, ch 20.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 19 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to A.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, Cl in next st, (sc in next 3 sts, Cl in next st) 4 times, sc in last st – 14 sc and 5 clusters.

Change to B.

Rows 5-7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to D.

Row 8: With D, rep Row 4.

Change to F.

Rows 9-13: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to E.

Row 14: With E, rep Row 4.

Change to B.

Rows 15-17: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to G.

Row 18: With G, rep Row 4.

Change to B.

Rows 19-21: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

SQUARE II (make 4)

Make same as Square I, using the following colors:

Beg ch and Rows 1-3: Work with G.

Row 4: Work with A.

Rows 5-7: Work with G.

Row 8: Work with D.

Rows 9-13: Work with B.

Row 14: Work with C.

Rows 15-17: Work with G.

Row 18: Work with E.

Rows 19-21: Work with G.

SQUARE III (make 2)

Make same as Square I, using the following colors:

Beg ch and Rows 1-3: Work with F.

Row 4: Work with D.

Rows 5-7: Work with F.

Row 8: Work with A.

Rows 9-13: Work with B.

Row 14: Work with G.

Rows 15-17: Work with F.

Row 18: Work with E.

Rows 19-21: Work with F.

SQUARE IV (make 7)

With H, ch 20.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – 19 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts; rep from * to last 5 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in last 3 sts – 13 dc and 3 ch-2 sps.

Row 3: Ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), turn, sk first 3 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts; rep from * across working the last dc in top of turning ch – 13 dc and 3 ch-2 sps.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first st, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * across working the last 2 dc in the turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch – 15 dc and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, sk first st, *dc in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * to last 6 sts, dc in next 2 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next st, dc in top of turning ch – 13 dc and 3 ch-2 sps.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, sk first st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * to last 3 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in top of turning ch – 13 dc and 3 ch-2 sps.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, sk first st, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc in next st, dc in top of turning ch – 15 dc and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 8: Ch 3, turn, sk first st, dc in next st, *ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * to last 5 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, dc in top of turning ch – 13 dc and 3 ch-2 sps.

Row 9: Rep Row 3.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn, sk first st, dc in next 3 sts, (2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 4 sts) twice, 2 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch – 19 dc.

Fasten off.

SQUARE V (make 4)

With C, make same as Square IV.

SQUARE VI (make 2)

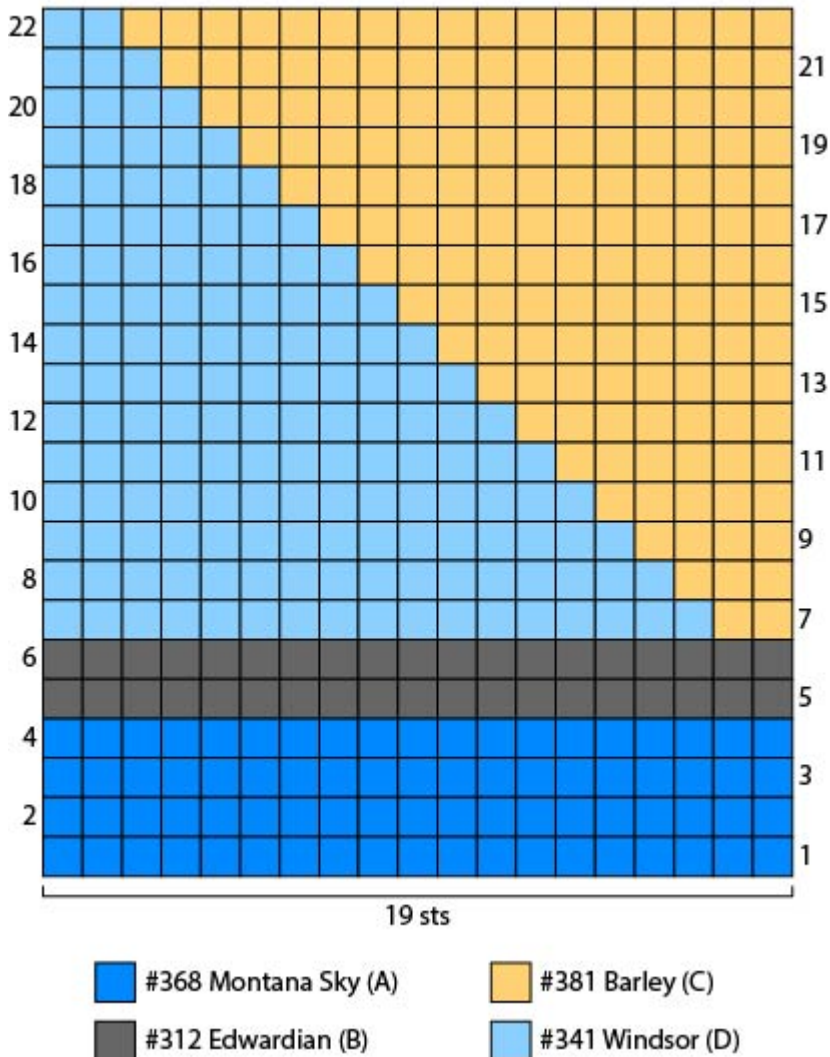
With D, make same as Square IV.

SQUARE VII (make 4)

Notes:

1. When working with more than one color in the same row, do not fasten off the old color. Drop the old color to the WS of the piece and pick it up again when needed as you work the next row.
2. Square VII can be worked by following written instructions or reading Chart. Read RS rows of Chart from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

SQUARE VII - CHART



With A, ch 20.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 19 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to B.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to C.

Row 7: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts; change to D, sc in last 17 sts.

Row 8: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 16 sts; change to C, sc in last 3 sts.

Row 9: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 4 sts; change to D, sc in last 15 sts.

Row 10: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 14 sts; change to C, sc in last 5 sts.

Row 11: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 6 sts; change to D, sc in last 13 sts.

Row 12: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 12 sts; change to C, sc in last 7 sts.

Row 13: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 8 sts; change to D, sc in last 11 sts.

Row 14: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 10 sts; change to C, sc in last 9 sts.

Row 15: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 10 sts; change to D, sc in last 9 sts.
Row 16: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 8 sts; change to C, sc in last 11 sts.
Row 17: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 12 sts; change to D, sc in last 7 sts.
Row 18: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 6 sts; change to C, sc in last 13 sts.
Row 19: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 14 sts; change to D, sc in last 5 sts.
Row 20: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 4 sts; change to C, sc in last 15 sts.
Row 21: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 16 sts; change to D, sc in last 3 sts.
Row 22: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts; change to C, sc in last 17 sts.
 Fasten off.

SQUARE VIII (make 3)

Make same as Square VII, using F instead of C and E instead of D.

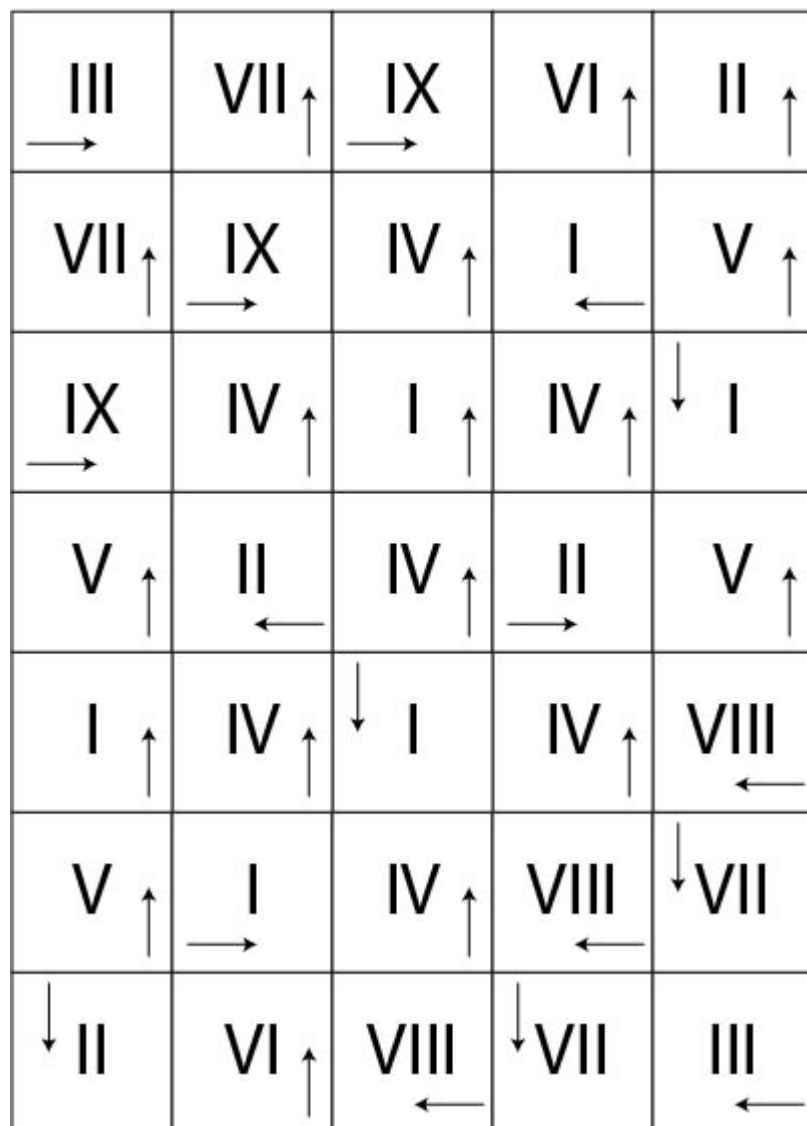
SQUARE IX (make 3)

Make same as Square VII, using E instead of C and F instead of D.

FINISHING

Sew Squares tog following Assembly Diagram.

ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



Border

From RS, join B with sl st anywhere in outer edge of Afghan.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around entire outer edge of Afghan, working 3 sc in each

corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in center sc of each corner 3-sc; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, join A with sc in any st along outer edge of Afghan, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in center sc of each corner 3-sc; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: With E, rep Rnd 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: With G, rep Rnd 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: With B, rep Rnd 3. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
