MATERIALS

• 752-100 <u>Lion Brand</u>

Fettuccini Yarn: Assorted 3 Balls

<u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
 <u>Hook - Size P-15 (10</u>
 mm)

<u>Lion Brand Split Ring</u>
 <u>Stitch Markers</u>

 Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6) *<u>Fettuccini®</u> (Article #752). 100% undetermined fibers textile by-products ; package size: 11.00oz/312.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

- 1. Bag is worked in one piece.
- 2. Base is worked back and forth in rows, then Bag is worked in the rnd.
- 3. The yarn color is changed to make stripes. Before beginning, designate the 3 yarn colors A, B and C.
- 4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

BAG

Base

With A, ch 21.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 20 sc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across, changing to B in last st of Row 5.

Begin Working in the Rnd

Rnd 1: With B, work 4 sc evenly spaced across short side of base (ends of rows); working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each ch across; work 4 sc evenly spaced along other short side of base; sc in each sc across top of Row 5 - 48 sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-7: With B, sc in each st around, changing to C in last st of Rnd 7.

Rnds 8-20: With C, sc in each st around, changing to A in last st of Rnd 20.

Handles

Next Rnd: With A, sc in next 11 sts, ch 6, sk next 6 sts, sc in next 18 sts, ch 6, sk next 6 sts, sc in last 7

sts

Next Rnd: Sc in each st and ch around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
