#### **MATERIALS**

- 136-149 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Great Smoky Mountains  
1 Ball (A)
- 136-174 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Joshua Tree  
1 Ball (B)
- 136-135 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn:  
Yosemite  
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10  
(6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles  
(Set of 6)

*\*Heartland (Article #136). Solids:*  
*100% Acrylic*  
*Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon;*  
*package size: Solids: 5oz/142g*  
*(251yd/230m)*  
*Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*



#### **GAUGE:**

14 hdc + 9 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).  
1 Square = about 8 1/2 x 8 1/2 in. (21.5 x 21.5 cm)

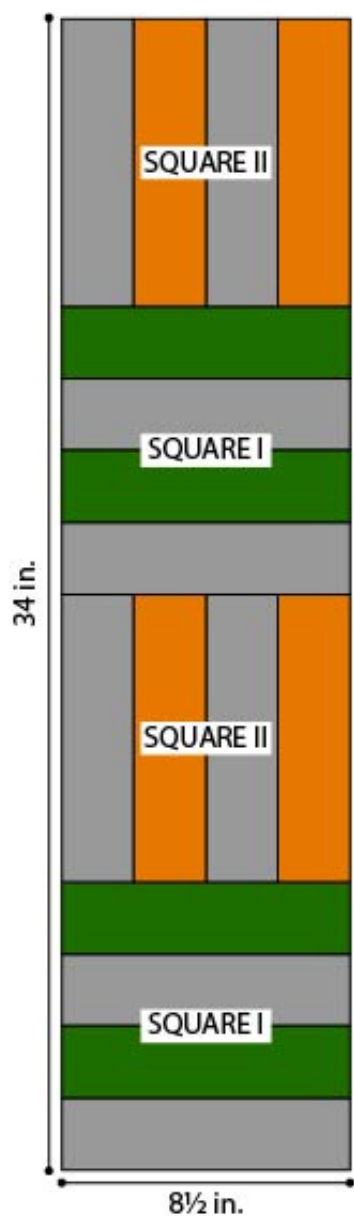
When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

1. Four Squares are worked individually, then sewn together following a diagram to make the Scarf.

2. Yarn color is changed on Squares to make blocks of color.
3. The beginning ch on each row does not count as a stitch.
4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.





### **SQUARE I (make 2)**

With A, ch 32.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 30 hdc.

**Rows 2-5:** With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across.

Change to B.

**Rows 6-10:** With B, rep Row 2 five times.

Change to A.

**Rows 11-15:** With A, rep Row 2 five times.

Change to B.

**Rows 16-20:** With B, rep Row 2 five times.

Fasten off.

### **SQUARE II (make 2)**

Make same as Square I using C instead of B for Rows 6-10 and 16-20.

### **FINISHING**

Following diagram, sew Squares together.

Weave in ends.
