MATERIALS

- 752-100 [Lion Brand Fettuccini Yarn: Assorted](#)
2 Balls (A)

**Fettuccini® (Article #752). 100% undetermined fibers - textile by-products ;
package size: 11.00oz/312.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins*

- 752-200 [Lion Brand Fettuccini Yarn: Solid](#)
5 Balls (B)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size Q-19 \(15mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



GAUGE:

5 sc + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

The Cozy is worked in one piece, first in the round, then divided for doorway.

COZY

Base

With A, ch 4; join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, 6 sc in ring, do not join. Place marker in first st; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around – you will have 18 sc at the end of Rnd 3.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.
Rnd 5: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.
Rnd 6: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 36 sc.
Rnd 7: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around – 42 sc.
Rnd 8: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around – 48 sc.
Rnd 9: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from * around – 54 sc.
Rnd 10: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 60 sc.

Fasten off A and remove marker.

Rnd 11: Join B with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of base, ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc – 60 sc.

Place marker in first st, move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 12 and 13: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Remove marker at end of Rnd 13.

Doorway

Note: For doorway, you will be working in rows instead of rounds.

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in next 54 sc, leave last 6 sts unworked.

Row 15 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 50 sts, sc2tog – 52 sts.

Rows 16-20: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Top

Note: For top, change back to working in rounds.

Rnd 21 (Joining Rnd): Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each of first 2 sts, sc in next 48 sts, 2 sc in each of last 2 sts, ch 4; join with sl st in first sc – 56 sc and 4 ch.

Rnd 22: (RS) Ch 1, turn, sc in each of next 4 ch and in each sc around, do not join – 60 sc.

Place marker in first st; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 23: *Sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 55 sc.

Rnd 24: *Sc in next 9 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 50 sc.

Rnd 25: *Sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog, rep from * around – 45 sc.

Rnd 26: *Sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnd 27: *Sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 35 sc.

Rnd 28: *Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 29: *Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 25 sc.

Rnd 30: *Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 20 sc.

Rnd 31: *Sc2tog; rep from * around – 10 sc.

Rnd 32: *Sc2tog; rep from * around – 5 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail in and out of sts on last rnd and pull to gather.

Knot securely.

Doorway Trim

From RS, join A with a sl st in any stitch around doorway opening. Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around doorway; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
