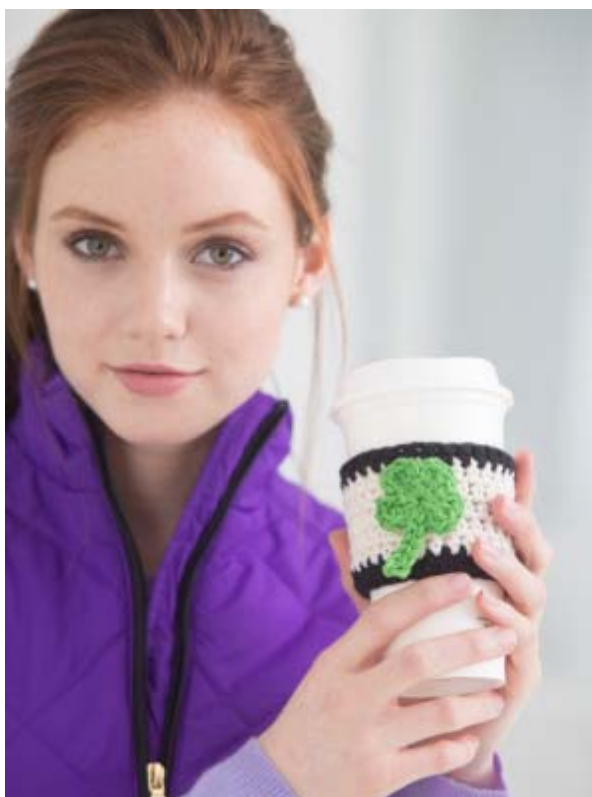

# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Kitchen Cotton

### Shamrock Cup Cozy

Pattern Number: L40739

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 3 x 9 in. (7.5 x 23 cm), to fit a standard coffee or tea cup

#### **MATERIALS**

- 831-130 Lion Brand Kitchen Cotton Yarn: Snap Pea

1 Ball (A)

- 831-098 Lion Brand Kitchen Cotton Yarn: Vanilla

1 Ball (B)

- 831-153 Lion Brand Kitchen Cotton Yarn: Licorice

1 Ball (C)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8 (5 mm)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Kitchen Cotton (Article #831). 100% Cotton; package size: 2.00oz/57.00 gr. (99yds/90m) pull skeins*



#### **GAUGE:**

14 hdc + 10 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

1. Cozy is worked in one piece in the round changing yarn color to make stripes.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.
3. Shamrock is made separately, then sewn to Cozy.
4. Yarn amount is sufficient to make 4-5 Cozies.

#### **COZY**

With C, ch 30.

Slip st in beginning ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each ch around – you will have 30 hdc at the end of this rnd. Join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2.

Change to B.

**Rnd 2:** With B, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st around, join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2.

**Rnds 3-6:** Repeat Rnd 2, changing to C in last st of Rnd 6.

**Rnd 7:** With C, repeat Rnd 2.

Fasten off.

### SHAMROCK

With A, ch 3, 2 dc in first ch, ch 2, slip st in same ch, \*(ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2, slip st) in same ch; repeat from \* twice more (four petals made), ch 7, sc in 3rd ch from hook, slip st into next 4 ch, slip st in same ch as petals.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

### FINISHING

With yarn tail, sew Shamrock to Cozy.

Weave in ends.
