*Vanna's Glamour (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins

MATERIALS

• 861-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: <u>Onyx</u>

3 Balls (A)

• 601-650 <u>Lion</u> Brand Bonbons Yarn: Party 3 Balls (B)

• Lion Brand Crochet Hook -Size G-6 (4 mm)

 Lion Brand Large-**Eve Blunt Needles** (Set of 6)

*Bonbons (Article #601).

Cotton: 100% Cotton. Care: Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene. Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. Care: Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. Care: Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: Cotton: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight $8 \times .35oz/10q$ 8 x 28yd/26m

Acrylic: Weight Category 3: DK Weight $8 \times .35oz/10q$ 8 x 28yd/26m

Metallic: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight $8 \times .35oz/10q$ 8 x 38.3 yd/35m



GAUGE:

One Square = about $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} \text{ in. } (6.5 \times 6.5 \text{ cm}).$


When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Shawl is made from 140 Squares: 10 Squares worked with each color of B for a total of 80 Squares and 60 Squares worked with A.
- 2. Squares are crocheted tog following a diagram.
- 3. Border is worked around entire outer edge of assembled Shawl.





SQUARES (make 140 – 60 with A and 10 with each color of B)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 1, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Four 3-dc groups and 4 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2: SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (3 dc, ch 1, 4 dc) in same ch-1 sp (first corner made), *(4 dc, ch 1, 4 dc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times; join with sI st in top of beg ch – Eight 4-dc groups and 4 corner ch-1 sps.

Rnd 3: SI st in next 3 dc, sI st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (3 dc, ch 1, 4 dc) in same ch-1 sp (first corner made), *sk next 4-dc group, 3 dc in sp between last 4-dc group and next 4-dc group, (4 dc, ch 1, 4 dc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, sk next 4-dc group, 3 dc in sp between last 4-dc group and next 4-dc group; join with sI st in top of beg ch – Eight 4-dc groups, four 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Following diagram, arrange Squares into a rectangle of 20 rows of 7 Squares each, with B Squares placed as desired. From RS, crochet the corners of neighboring Squares tog.

When joining Squares along the edges of the Shawl follow the "Join 2 Corners" instructions. For all other Squares, follow the "Join 4 Corners" instructions. All Squares are joined tog using A.

Join 2 Corners: From RS, join A with a sl st in corner of first Square, ch 1, yarn over, insert hook into corresponding corner of neighboring Square and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1, sl st in beg ch-1.

Fasten off.

Tie securely and weave in ends.

Join 4 Corners: From RS, join A with a sl st in corner of first Square, *ch 1, yarn over, insert hook into corresponding corner of next neighboring Square and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all loops on hook; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, sl st in beg ch-1.

Fasten off. Tie securely and weave in ends.

FINISHING

Border

From RS, join A with sl st in center dc of 3-dc group on side of any Square, *ch 5, sc in join between Squares, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sl st) in center dc of next 3-dc group; rep from * around, working (sc, ch 5, sl st) in each corner; join with sl st in same sp as first sl st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
