   1 Ball
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles-</u> Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- <u>Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch</u> Markers
- <u>Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u>
   <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>
- Additional Materials
   Fairy Moon LED String Lights (12 lights, 4.5 ft wire and battery pack) 2 sets

**400**, **401**, **403**: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

### **GAUGE:**

18 sts = about 4 in. in Seed st.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Seed St (multiple of 2 sts)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row. **Row 2:** P the knit sts, and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. Wristers are worked flat, in Seed st and a cable, then seamed.
- 2. LED lights are woven into the inside of the Wristers.

# WRISTERS (make 2)

Cast on 36 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Seed st over first 12 sts, place marker (pm), work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) over next 12 sts, pm, work Row 1 of Seed st to end of row.

Row 2 and All WS Rows: Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker (sm), work in St st to next marker, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

Row 3: Work in Seed st to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

**Row 5:** Work in Seed st to marker, sm, slip next 3 sts to a cable needle and hold at back of work, k3, k3 from cable needle, slip next 3 sts to a cable needle and hold at front of work, k3, k3 from cable needle, sm, work in Seed st to end of row.

Rows 7 and 9: Rep Row 3.

**Row 10:** Rep Row 2.

Rows 11-30: Rep Rows 1-10.

Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Sew sides of each Wrister together to make a tube.

Weave in ends.

From WS, weave LED lights along the sides of the cable, with 6 lights along each side. To wear, tuck battery pack inside the Wrister.
