MATERIALS

LION BRAND[®] LION'S PRIDE[®] WOOLSPUN[®] (Art. #671) #153 Black 4 balls (A) #099 Linen 4 balls (B) #149 Charcoal 2 balls (C) #150 Oxford Grey 2 balls (D) #123 Taupe 2 balls (E) or colors of your choice
LION BRAND[®] knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)

• LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

SIZE

About 45 x 54 in. (114.5 x 137 cm)

NOTES

- 1. 5 Strips are worked then sewn together following a diagram to make the Afghan.
- Each Strip is worked with 2 colors of yarn. The colors change on each step so when you finish a step, you'll cut the colors you don't need anymore. Whenever you cut a color or join a color, leave yarn tails at least 6 in. (15 cm) long. You'll weave in these yarn tails after you finish the knitting.
- 3. In Steps 2-8 and Steps 10-19, you'll work 2 rows with one color, then 2 rows with the second color. You don't need to cut the yarns between these color changes just carry the color you're not using along the side edge of the Strip. Just let the strand of yarn lay smoothly against the Strip don't pull it too tight!
- 4. The steps are worked in a 4 row pattern this means that you just keep repeating Rows 1-4 for as many times as the pattern tell you to.
- 5. When the pattern says to slip a st, hold the yarn to the back of your work and slip the st just as if you were purling.

STEP 1 - STRIP I (make 3)

With A, cast on 25 sts. Purl 1 row.

STEP 2

In Step 2, you'll be working with colors A and C. Remember that you don't need to cut either color, just carry the color you're not using along the side edge until you need it again. Join C.

Row 1: With C, p1, *sl 1, p1; rep from * across.

Row 2: With C, purl.

Row 3: With A, p2, sl 1, *p1, sl 1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 4: With A, purl.

Rows 5-48: Rep Rows 1-4 eleven more times.



STEP 3

Cut C and join D.

For Step 3, you'll be working with D and A, carrying whichever color you're not using along the side edge until you need it again.

Rep Rows 1-48 of Step 2, but use D for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 4

Cut D and A and join B and C. **Rows 1-4:** Rep Rows 1-4 of Step 2, but use C for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4. **Rows 5-32:** Rep Rows 1-4 seven more times.



STEP 5

Cut C and join D. Rep Rows 1-32 of Step 4, but use D for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 6

Cut D and join E. Rep Rows 1-32 of Step 4, but use E for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 7

Cut B and join A. Rep Rows 1-48 of Step 2, but use E for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 8

Cut E and join B. Rep Rows 1-48 of Step 2, but use B for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4. Cut B. With A, bind off.

STEPS 3-8



STEP 9 - STRIP II (make 2)

With B, cast on 25 sts. Purl 1 row.

STEP 10

Join E.

Row 1: With E, p1, *sl 1, p1; rep from * across.
Row 2: With E, purl.
Row 3: With B, p2, sl 1, *p1, sl 1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.
Row 4: With B, purl.
Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4 three more times.

STEP 11

Cut E and join D.

Rep Rows 1-16 of Step 10, but use D for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4.



STEP 12

Cut D and join C. Rep Rows 1-16 of Step 10, but use C for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4.



STEPS 11-19

STEP 13

Cut C and join A. **Rows 1-4:** Rep Rows 1-4 of Step 10, but use B for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4. **Rows 5-48:** Rep Rows 1-4 eleven more times.

STEP 14

Cut B and join E. Rep Rows 1-48 of Step 13, but use E for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 15

Cut E and join D. Rep Rows 1-48 of Step 13, but use D for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 16

Cut D and join C. Rep Rows 1-48 of Step 13, but use C for Rows 1 and 2 and A for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 17

Cut C and A and join B and E. Rep Rows 1-16 of Step 10, but use E for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 18

Cut E and join D. Rep Rows 1-16 of Step 10, but use D for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4.

STEP 19

Cut D and join C. Rep Rows 1-16 of Step 10, but use C for Rows 1 and 2 and B for Rows 3 and 4. Cut C. With B, bind off.

FINISHING

Sew Strips tog following diagram. Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)
p = purl
rep = repeat
sl = slip
st(s) = stitch(es)
tog = together
