Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

**Modern Baby (Article #924). 50% Acrylic, 50% Nylon; package size: 2.60oz/75.00 gr. (173yds/158m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

20 sts + 31 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from

person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Surface Chain Stitch

Thread needle and bring from back to front through piece. *Hold short length of yarn on front forming a small loop. Insert needle back into where it last came out, do not pull tight. Bring needle back through work and through small loop; repeat from * until chain is desired length.

NOTES:

1. Afghan is worked in one piece in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with Garter st (k every row) borders.
2. The Garter st borders are always worked with A. Wind A and C into 3 separate balls before beginning.
3. Pot 'O Gold and Sun motifs are worked in intarsia colorwork following charts, using a separate ball of yarn for each section of color.
4. When following charts, work in St st and read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
5. Twist yarns on WS to prevent holes. Do not carry color not in use across WS.
6. Small details are worked separately, then sewn to Afghan.

AFGHAN

With circular needle and A, cast on 144 sts.

Working back and forth in rows on circular needle, work in Garter St (k every row) for 10 rows.

Begin Rainbow

Note: The rainbow is worked in intarsia colorwork, using a separate ball of yarn for each color section.

Row 1 (RS): With A, k5 (Garter st border), with A, k7, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C k to last 5 sts, with A, k5 (Garter st border).

Row 2 (WS): Keeping the first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, work in St st across rem sts using each color in turn as established.

Rows 3-5: Rep Row 2.

Row 6: With A, k5, with C, p85, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 7-10: Rep Row 2.

Row 11: With A, k5, with A, k9, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 12-14: Rep Row 2.

Begin Pot 'o Gold Chart

Row 15: With A, k5, with A, k9, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k 26, place marker (pm), working in St st, work Row 1 of Pot 'o Gold chart across next 40 sts, pm, join a 2nd ball of C and k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Row 16: With A, k5, with C, p to marker, slip marker (sm), working in St st, work Row 2 of chart over next 40 sts, sm, with C, p25, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 17-20: Keep first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, sts between markers in St st and following chart, and sts for rainbow in colors as established.

Row 21: With A, k5, with A, k11, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 22-25: Rep Rows 17-20.

Row 26: With A, k5, with C, p to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, p23, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 27-30: Rep Rows 17-20.

Row 31: With A, k5, with A, k13, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 32-35: Rep Rows 17-20.

Row 36: With A, k5, with C, p to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, p21, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 37-40: Rep Rows 17-20.

Row 41 (RS): With A, k5, with A, k15, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 42-45: Rep Rows 17-20.

Row 46 (WS): With A, k5, with C, p to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, p19, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 47-50: Rep Rows 17-20.

Row 51 (RS): With A, k5, with A, k17, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 52-54: Keep first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, sts between markers in St st and following chart, and sts for rainbow in colors as established.

Row 55: With A, k5, with A, k18, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 56-58: Rep Rows 52-54.

Row 59: With A, k5, with A, k19, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 60 and 61: Keep first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, sts between markers in St st and following chart, and sts for rainbow in colors as established.

Row 62 (WS): With A, k5, with C, p to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, p15, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 63 and 64: Rep Rows 60 and 61.

Row 65: With A, k5, with A, k21, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C, k to marker, sm, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 66 and 67: Rep Rows 60 and 61, removing markers as you work Row 67.

Row 68: With A, k5, with C, p70, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 69 and 70: Keeping the first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, work in St st across rem sts using each color in turn as established.

Row 71: With A, k5, with A, k23, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7 sts, with C, k to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 72, 73, 75, 77, 79 and 81: Keeping the first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, work in St st across rem sts using each color in turn as established.

Row 74: With A, k5, with C, p68, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Row 76: With A, k5, with C, p67, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Row 78: With A, k5, with C, p66, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Row 80: With A, k5, with C, p65, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Rows 82-158: Continue to work in Garter and St st, moving each color in rainbow over 1 st every WS row as established.

Begin Sun Chart

Reminder – when working from chart, do not carry color not in use across WS – instead, use a separate ball of yarn for each color section.

Row 1 (RS): With A, k5, pm, working in St st, work Row 1 of Sun Chart over next 36 sts, pm, with second

ball of A, k30, with B, k7, with C, k7, with D, k7, with E, k7, with F, k7, with G, k7, with C knit to last 5 sts, with A, k5.

Row 2: With A, k5, with C, p 25, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to marker, sm, working in St st, work next row of Sun Chart to next marker, sm, with A, k5.

Row 3: With A, k5, sm, working in St st, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, work in St st to last 5 sts, working rem sts using each color in turn as established, with A, k5.

Row 4: With A, k5, with C, p 24, with G, p7, with F, p7, with E, p7, with D, p7, with C, p7, with B, p7, with A, p to marker, sm, working in St st, work next row of chart to next marker, sm, with A, k5.

Continue as established, working first and last 5 sts in Garter st with A, chart as established between markers, and moving each color in rainbow over one st on every WS row as established.

Work until you've finished Row 51 of Chart.

With A, work in Garter st for 10 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Pot 'O Gold Handle

With D and double pointed needles, and leaving a long beginning yarn tail, cast on 4 sts. Knit the sts. Do not turn work.

*Slide sts to other end of needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work, (do not turn work); rep from * until piece measures about 11 in. (28 cm). Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread tail through rem sts. With yarn tails, sew ends of handle to pot.

Gold Coins in Pot

With E, work surface chain st around coins in pot.

Gold Coins

Make as many or as few coins as desired, our designer made 13.

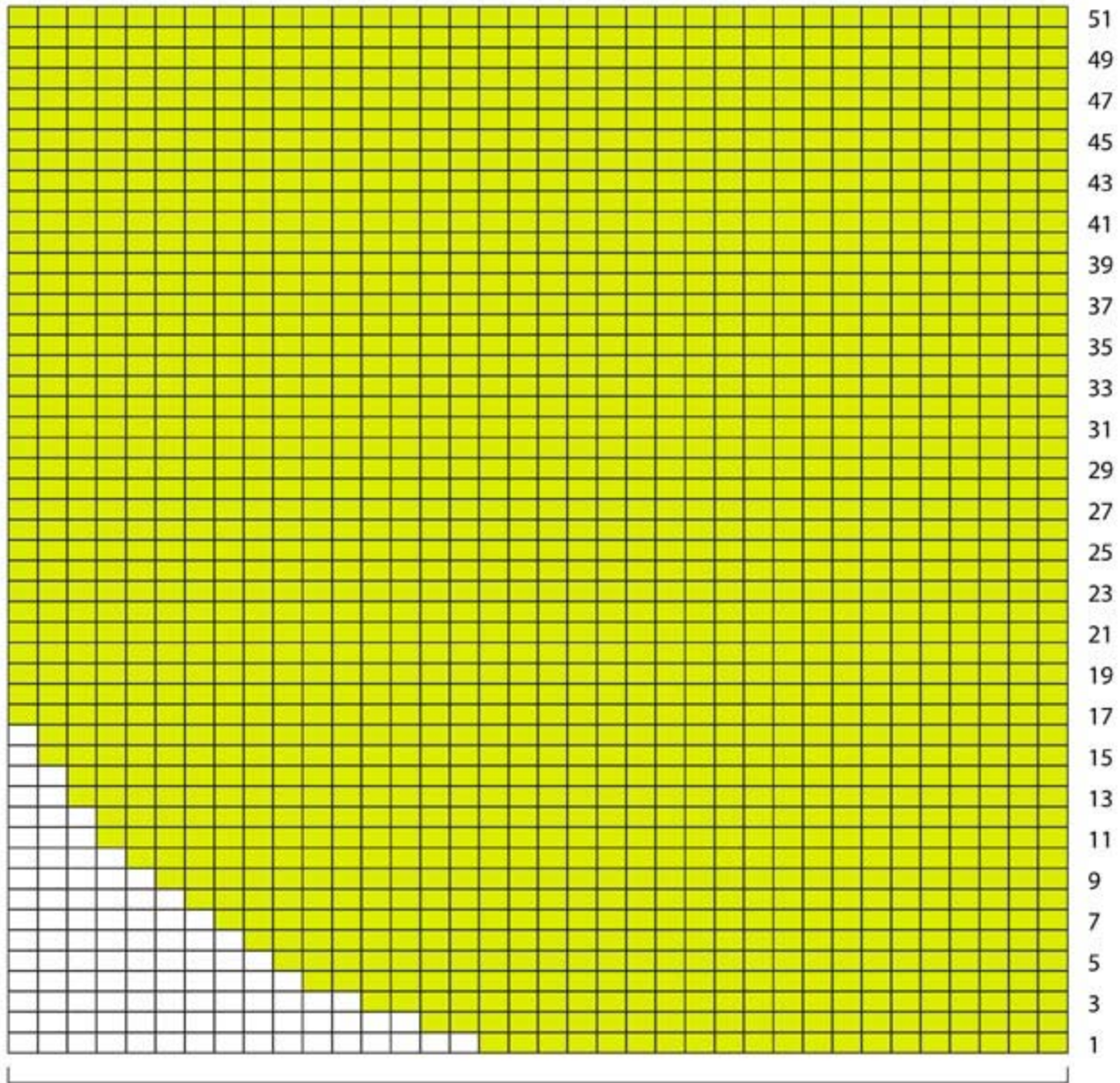
With crochet hook and E, ch 16 for smaller coins and 20 for larger coins. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Coil each chain into a spiral and, with yarn tail, sew to Afghan.

Sun Rays

With E, work surface chain st rays, about 1 in. (2.5 cm) long.

Weave in ends.
