SKILL LEVEL: [Beginner \(Level 1\)](#)

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X

Finished Bust About 40 (44, 48, 52, 56, 60) in. (101.5 (112, 122, 132, 142, 152.5) cm)

Finished Length About 23 (23 1/2, 24, 24, 24 1/2, 25) in. (58.5 (59.5, 61, 61, 62, 63.5) cm)

Scarf measures about 6 1/2 x 40 in. (16.5 x 101.5 cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 790-436 [Lion Brand Homespun: Claret](#)
5 5, 6, 6, 7, 7 Balls
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles](#)
- Size 10 [6 mm]
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester;
package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

12 sts + 16 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Seed St.

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Seed St (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): *K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed St.

NOTES:

1. Cardi is worked in 6 easy pieces: Back, 2 Fronts, 2 Sleeves and Scarf. All pieces are worked in Seed St.
2. Seed St is reversible, so there is no specific RS or WS and the 2 Fronts are worked exactly the same. Simply flip one of the Fronts over before sewing the shoulders.
3. The Scarf is sewed around the neck of the Cardi.

BACK

Cast on 59 (65, 71, 77, 83, 89) sts.

Work in Seed St until piece measures about 23 (23 1/2, 24, 24, 24 1/2, 25) in. (58.5 (59.5, 61, 61, 62, 63.5) cm) from beg.

Bind off.



FRONTS (make 2)

Note: When working the Fronts, you'll be decreasing the number of sts to shape the neck.

Cast on 35 (37, 41, 43, 47, 49) sts.

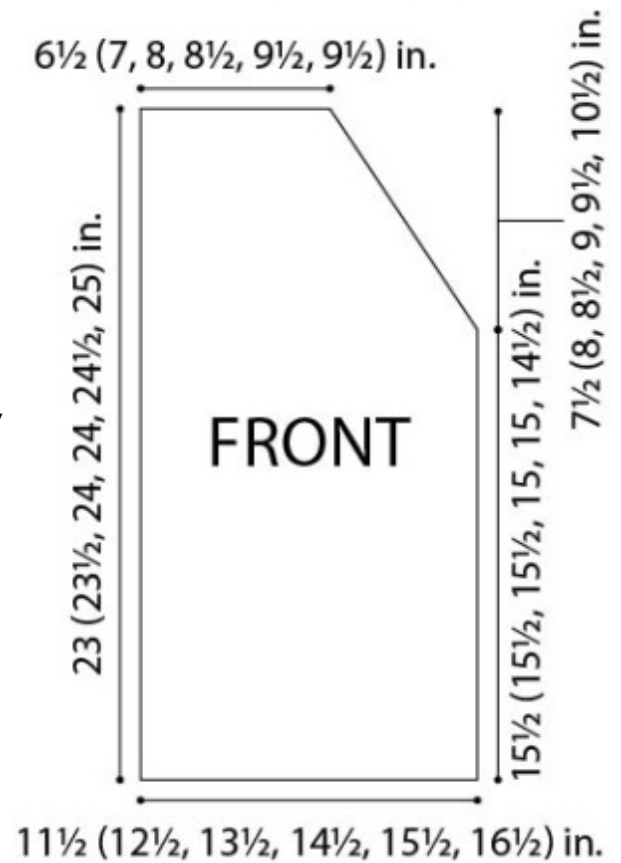
Work in Seed St until piece measures about 15 1/2 (15 1/2, 15 1/2, 15, 15, 14 1/2) in. (39.5 (39.5, 39.5, 38, 38, 37) cm) from beg.

Shape Neck

Row 1: K1, k next 2 sts together, work in Seed St to end of row – you will have 34 (36, 40, 42, 46, 48) sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Work in Seed St to end of row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until only 20 (21, 24, 25, 28, 28) sts remain. Bind off.

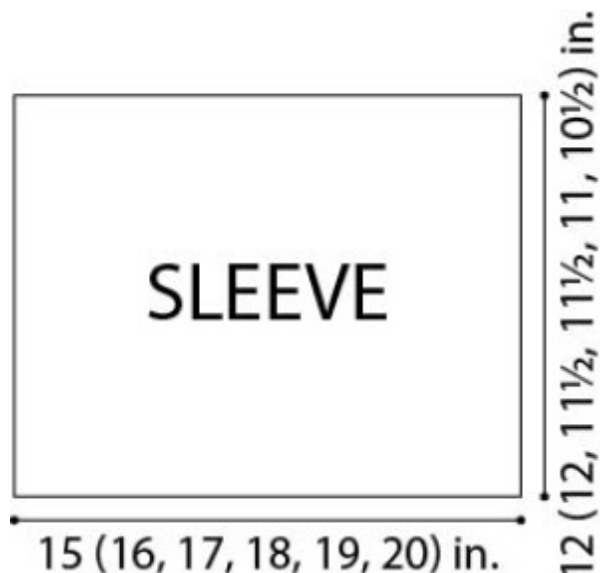


SLEEVES (make 2)

Cast on 45 (49, 51, 55, 57, 61) sts.

Work in Seed St until piece measures about 12 (12, 11 1/2, 11 1/2, 11, 10 1/2) in. (30.5 (30.5, 29, 29, 28, 26.5) cm) from beg.

Bind off.



SCARF

Cast on 19 sts.

Work in Seed St until piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Place markers on side edges of Back and Fronts, about 7 1/2 (8, 8 1/2, 9, 9 1/2, 10) in. (19 (20.5, 21.5, 23, 24, 25.5) cm) from shoulder seam. Sew top of one Sleeve between markers on each side.

Fold Fronts over Back and sew side and Sleeve seams.

Fold Scarf in half to find the center of one long edge, then place a marker at this point. Fold Cardigan in half to find center of back neck and place a marker at this point.

Matching markers, sew Scarf to Back neck edge and to about 1 in. (2.5 cm) of each Front neck edge.

Weave in ends.
