GAUGE:

20 1/2 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with Garter st (k every row) borders.
2. Shamrock is worked in intarsia colorwork, changing color following charts and using a separate ball of yarn for each section of color.
3. When following chart, twist yarns on WS to prevent holes. Do not carry color not in use across WS. When following chart, you'll need 4 separate strands of A and 3 of B. Before beginning, wind a small amount each of A and B into separate balls – so that you'll have 4 balls of A and 3 balls of B.
4. When following charts, work in St st and read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS), changing color as follows:

Rows 1-24: *Work 4 rows in C, then 4 rows in B; rep from * twice more.

Rows 25-48: Rep Rows 1-24, using D instead of C.

Rows 49-72: Rep Rows 1-24, using E instead of C.

Rows 73-96: Rep Rows 1-24, using A instead of C.

Rows 97-120: Rep Rows 1-24, using F instead of C.

Rep Rows 1-120 once for 240 rows of Stripe Sequence.

SCARF

With straight needles and A, cast on 33 sts.

Rows 1-8: Work in Garter st (knit every row).

Row 9 (RS): With A, k4, with B, k to last 4 sts, join a 2nd ball of A and k4.

Rows 10-16: With A, k4, with B, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) to last 4 sts, with B, k 4.

Begin Shamrock Chart 1

Reminder – when working from charts, do not carry color not in use across WS – instead, use a separate ball of yarn for each color section.

Next Row (RS): With A, k4, with B k4, work Row 1 of Shamrock Chart 1 across next 17 sts, with B, k4, with A, k4.

Continue in Garter and St st as established, and following Shamrock Chart 1 until you've finished Row 16 of Chart 1.

Next Row: With A, k4, with B, work in St st to last 4 sts, with B, k 4.

Rep last row 5 more times.

Begin Stripe Sequence

Keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st with A, work in St st, changing color following Stripe Sequence, until you've finished all 240 rows of Stripe Sequence.

Next Row: With A, k4, with B, work in St st to last 4 sts, with B, k 4.

Rep last row 5 more times.

Begin Shamrock Chart 2

Next Row (RS): With A, k4, with B k4, work Row 1 of Shamrock Chart 2 across next 17 sts, with B, k4, with A, k4.

Continue in Garter and St st as established, and following Shamrock Chart 2 until you've finished Row 16 of Chart 2.

Next Row: With A, k4, with B, work in St st to last 4 sts, with B, k 4.

Rep last row 7 more times.

Last 8 Rows: Work in Garter st.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Shamrock Stems (make 2)

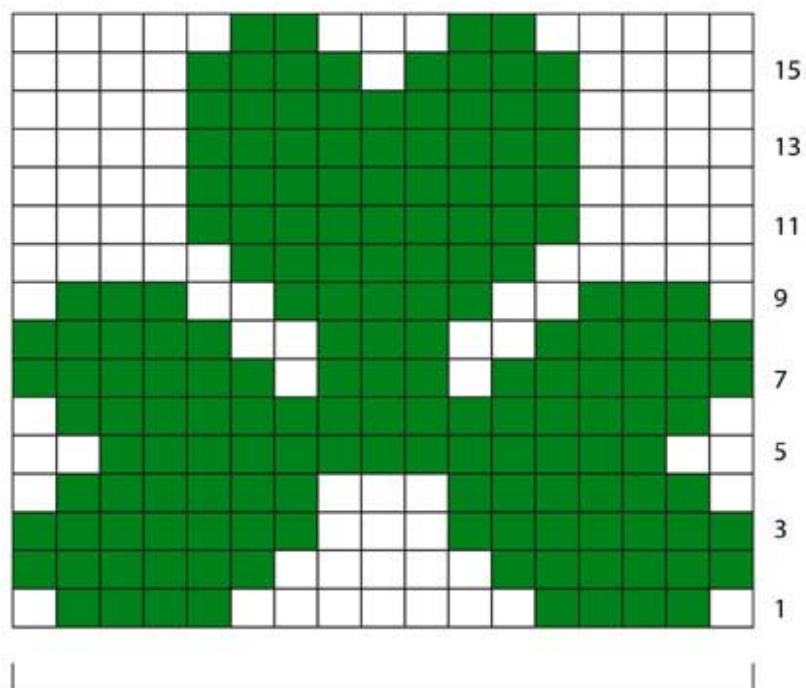
Stem is worked on 2 double pointed needles.

With 2 double pointed needles and A, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: Knit. *Do not turn work, slide sts to other end of needle and pulling yarn tight across back of work,

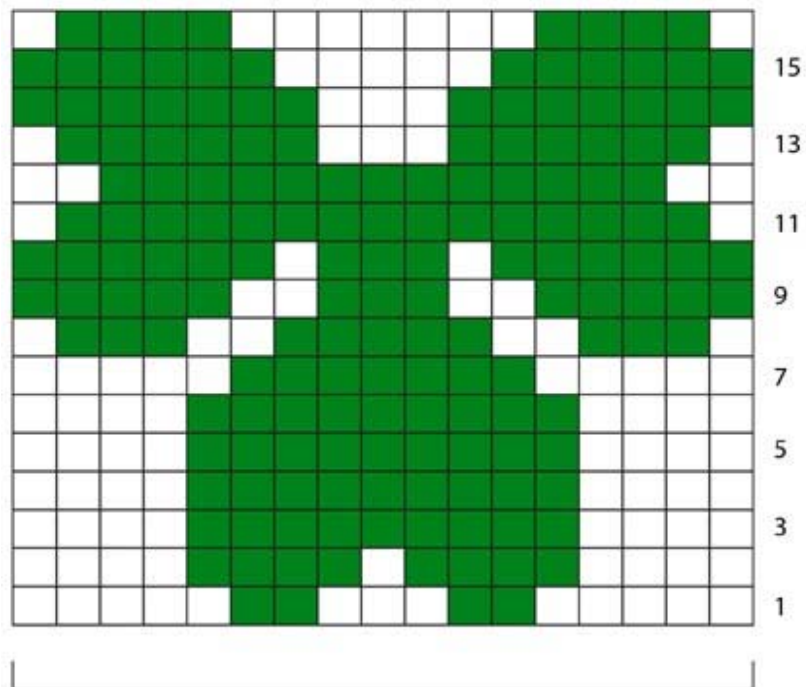
knit; rep from * until piece measures approximately 3 in. (7.5 cm). Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through rem sts, then sew stem to shamrock and Scarf. Make another stem for opposite end of Scarf. Weave in ends.
