#### MATERIALS

- 135-149 [Lion Brand Hometown USA](#)  
Yarn: [Dallas Grey](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 135-100 [Lion Brand Hometown USA](#)  
Yarn: [New York White](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- 135-111 [Lion Brand Hometown USA](#)  
Yarn: [San Diego Navy](#)  
1 Ball (C)
- 135-114 [Lion Brand Hometown USA](#)  
Yarn: [Tampa Spice](#)  
1 Ball (D)

*\*Hometown USA (Article #135). Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



#### GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

#### NOTES:

1. Arm knitting is a fun, fast technique that creates a wonderfully open fabric! The openness of the fabric can be altered by how tight or loose you choose to make your stitches.
2. The Cowl is arm knit as a simple rectangle with 4 strands of yarn held together.

#### COWL

With 1 strand each of A, B, C and D (4 strands total), cast on 7 stitches following Lion Brand Yarn video instructions, "How To Arm Knit":

Arm knit until piece measures about 36 in. (91.5 cm).  
Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Hold the ends of the piece together and with your fingers weave yarn tail in and out through the ends to join them. Then weave yarn tail through stitches to hide the tail.
