• 790-408 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Wild Fire

2 Balls Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5

(6.5 mm)

 Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

\*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins



### GAUGE:

10 sc = 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## NOTES:

- 1. Hood is worked in joined rnds. At the end of each rnd, join last st with sl st in first st. Turn work at the beg of each rnd. < br < 2. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 61, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with sl st in first sc -60 sc. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.
- 3. Drawstring is worked first.

# **DRAWSTRING**

Make a chain about 36 in. (91.5 cm) long.

Row 1: SI st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across.

Fasten off.

#### HOOD

Ch 60; taking care not to twist the ch; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and in each ch around; join with sl st in first sc – 60 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), turn, dc in each sc around; join with sl st in top of turning ch.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Repeat Rnds 2 and 3 until piece measures about 19 in. (48.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

Weave Drawstring through Hood, about 5 in. (12.5 cm) below top edge, weaving in and out about every 1 in. (2.5 cm).
