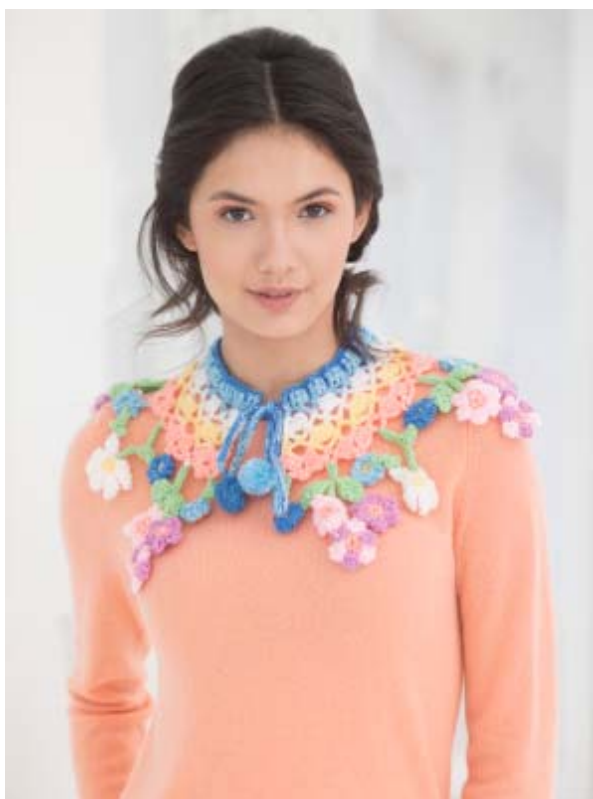

Cotton: 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size:

GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION

Adjustable Ring Method

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 (in pattern, below) into the ring. When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

NOTES:

1. Collar, flowers, and leaves are crocheted separately then sewed together.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and

draw through all loops to complete st. Fasten off old color.

COLORS

Medium Blue (A)

Sky Blue (B)

White (C)

Yellow (D)

Peach (E)

Pale Pink (F)

Lavender (G)

Light Green (H)

COLLAR

With A, ch 71.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 70 sc. Change to B.

Row 2: With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 4, sk next 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from * across working the last sc in top of turning ch – 24 sc and 23 ch-4 sps. Change to C.

Row 4: With C, ch 3, turn, 4 dc in first ch-4 sp, *ch 2, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, 4 dc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * across to last st, dc in last st – 50 dc, 11 sc, and 22 ch-2 sps.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * to last 5 sts, ch 4, sk next 4 sts, sc in last st (top of turning ch) – 24 sc, 12 ch-4 sps, and 11 ch-5 sps. Change to D.

Row 6: With D, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sc in first ch-4 sp, *ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * across, ch 2, dc in last st – Eleven 5-dc groups and 24 ch-2 sps.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk first ch-2 sp, *ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-2 sp; rep from * across to turning ch-sp, ch 4, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch – 12 ch-4 sps and 11 ch-5 sps. Change to E.

Row 8: With E, ch 3, turn, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-4 sp (shell made), *ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-4 sp; rep from * across, dc in last st – 12 shells.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 4, (sc, ch 3, sc) in first ch-2 sp, *(ch 4, sc in next ch-2 sp) twice, ch 4, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * across, ch 4, sc in last dc (top of turning ch) – 48 sc, 12 ch-3 sps, and 35 ch-4 sps.

Fasten off.

Flower 1 (make 12 – 6 each using F and G as 2nd color)

With E, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, 11 sc in ring; change to 2nd color; join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: With 2nd color, (hdc, 2 dc, hdc) in first sc (petal made), *sc in next sc, (hdc, 2 dc, hdc) in next sc; rep from * 4 more times; join with sl st in first sc – 6 petals. Fasten off.

Flower 2 (make 6)

With E, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, 11 sc in ring; change to F; join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: With F, ch 1, (hdc, 2 dc, hdc) in first sc (petal made); *change to G, sc in next sc, (hdc, 2 dc, hdc) in next sc; change to F, sc in next sc, (hdc, 2 dc, hdc) in next sc; rep from * once more; change to G, sc in next sc, (hdc, 2 dc, hdc) in next sc; join with sl st in first sc – 6 petals. Fasten off.

Flower 3 (make 5)

With D, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 2, 6 dc in ring, change to C; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 2: With C, *ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch (petal made), sl st in next dc of Rnd 1; rep from * 6 more times working last sl st in same st as joining sl st of Rnd 1 – 7 petals.

Flower 4 (make 12 – 6 each using A and B as 2nd color)

With D, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 7 sc in ring; change to 2nd color; join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: With 2nd color, ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in next 7 sc; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Stem 1 (make 6)

With H, ch 6.

First Leaf: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, (sc, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc) in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, sl st in skipped ch at the beg of this rnd. Do not fasten off and do not turn.

First Half of Stem: Ch 6, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next 4 ch.

Second Half of Stem: Ch 6, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next 4 ch.

Second Leaf: Ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, (sc, ch 1, sc) in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc of 2nd leaf. Fasten off.

Stem 2 (make 5)

With H, ch 12 for stem.

Row 1: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 4 ch (first part of stem made), ch 4 for leaf, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch (leaf made), sk next ch of stem ch, sl st in next 5 ch (stem completed). Fasten off.

Stem 3 (make 7)

With H, ch 7.

Row 1: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in next ch (small leaf made), sl st in last 3 ch. Fasten off.

Tie

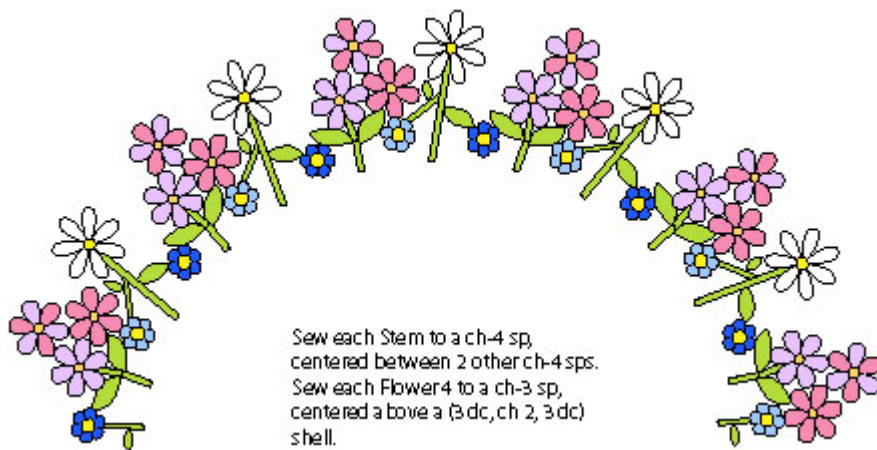
With 1 strand end of A and B held tog, make a ch about 50 in. (127 cm) long. Fasten off.

FINISHING

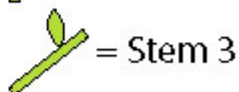
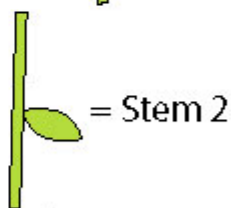
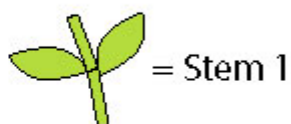
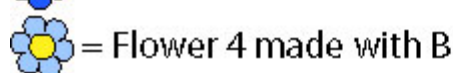
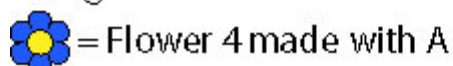
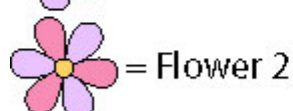
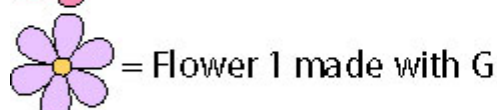
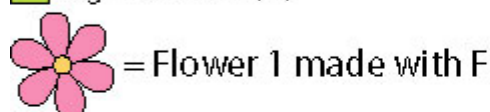
Following Assembly Diagram, sew flowers and stems to Collar. Thread tie through sts of Row 2 of Collar beg under 2nd dc, *sk 3 dc, and thread under the next dc; rep from * across.

Pom-poms (make 2 – 1 each with A and B)

Following package directions, make a small pom-pom. Tie a pom-pom to each end of tie. Weave in ends.
