*Homespun Thick & Quick (Article #792). 88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size: 8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins

GAUGE:

6 sts + 4 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

FPSC (front post single crochet) Insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook. Skip st behind the FPSC.

NOTES:

- 1. Beret is worked in joined rnds from top of Beret.
- 2. Scarf is worked back and forth in rows.

BERET

Note: Do not turn at ends of rnds.

Ch 3.

Rnd 1: Work 10 sc in 3rd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), *dc in next st, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – 10 dc and 10 ch-1 sps at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: SI st in first ch-1 sp, ch 2 (counts as first hdc in this rnd and in all following rnds), hdc in same ch-1 sp, ch 1, *2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 20 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 4: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *sk next hdc, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 30 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 5: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 40 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 6: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 50 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in next 4 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, *hdc in next 5 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 8 (Decrease): SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 3 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 4 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 40 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 9: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp,* sk next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 30 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 10: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 20 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Note: In following rnds, work first st in same st as joining.

Rnds 11-14: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sts, FPSC around next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 30 sts.

Fasten off.

SCARF

Ch 14.

Row 1: Hdc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as hdc, ch 1), *ch 1, sk next ch, hdc in next ch; rep from * across – 7 hdc and 6 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, hdc in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next hdc, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across working last hdc in turning ch-sp.

Rep Row 2 until almost all yarn has been used. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
