# **GAUGE:**

One Square = about  $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4}$  in.  $(8.5 \times 8.5 \text{ cm})$ .

When you match the <u>qauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

# Making a Gauge Swatch

# **NOTES:**

- 1. Scarf is made from 17 Squares sewed together.
- 2. Hat beg by making and sewing together 6 Squares. Top of Hat is worked beg around one edge of circle of Squares. Lower edge of Hat is worked beg around other edge of circle of Squares.
- 3. Squares are worked in the round, with RS always facing.
- 4. The color is changed on every round of each Square. Change color by fastening off old color and drawing up a loop of new color in a corner ch-2 space.

Bronze (A) Red (B) Copper (C) Gold (D)
Sparkling Taupe (E)
Magenta (F)
Teal (G)
Dark Purple (H)

#### **SCARF**

# Square I (make 5)

With C, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** From RS, draw up a loop of B in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), ch 1; rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 24 dc, 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 4 ch-1 sps at the end of this rnd. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** From RS, draw up a loop of A in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 36 dc, 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 8 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** From RS, draw up a loop of D in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 48 dc, 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 12 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

#### Square II (make 4)

Make same as Square I in the following Color Sequence: Work 1 rnd each with H, G, F, E.

# Square III (make 4)

Make same as Square I in the following Color Sequence: Work 1 rnd each with D, A, B, C.

# Square IV (make 4)

Make same as Square I in the following Color Sequence: Work 1 rnd each with E, F, G, H.

#### **FINISHING**

Arrange Squares into a strip in the following order: \*Square I, Square II, Square III, Square IV; rep from \* 3 more times, then add the last Square I.

Sew Squares tog using a color to match the center color of one of the Squares being joined.

#### **Border**

**Note:** To change color when working border, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color.

Proceed with new color.

From RS, draw up a loop of F in any corner ch-2 sp, so that you are ready to work across a long edge.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3, 2 dc in same corner ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp or next join between Squares) across long edge to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across short edge to next corner ch-2 sp \*\*, ch 1, 3 dc in corner ch-2 sp; ch 1, change to C, 3 dc in same corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* to \*\* working across other long edge and short edge, ch 1, 3 dc in same corner as joining, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off

From RS, draw up a loop of G in first corner ch-2 sp (where F-colored long edge beg).

Rnd 2: Work same as Rnd 1, changing to B in 3rd corner ch-2 sp. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

#### HAT

Note: Follow Scarf pattern to make Squares.

# Squares (make 6)

Make 2 each of Squares II and III, and one each of Squares I and IV.

Arrange Squares into a strip in the following order: Square I, Square II, Square III, Square III, Square III, Square III, Square IV. Sew Squares tog using a color to match the center color of one of the Squares being joined, then sew first and last Squares of strip together to make a ring.

# Crown (Top of Hat)

From RS, draw up a loop of F in any ch-1 sp on one edge of ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp or next join between Squares (do not work into the corner ch-2 sps of the Squares); rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twenty-four 3-dc groups. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** From RS, draw up a loop of G in any ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: With H, rep Rnd 2. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: With E, rep Rnd 2. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: With C, rep Rnd 2. Fasten off.

**Rnd 6:** From RS, draw up a loop of B in any ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eighteen 3-dc groups and 6 dc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 7:** From RS, draw up a loop of A in any dc not part of a 3-dc group, ch 3, 2 dc in same dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice, \*sk next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eighteen 3-dc groups. Fasten off.

**Rnd 8:** From RS, draw up a loop of D in any ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups and 6 dc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 9:** From RS, draw up a loop of H in any dc not a part of a 3-dc group, ch 3, 2 dc in same dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups. Fasten off.

**Rnd 10:** From RS, draw up a loop of G in any ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Six 3-dc groups and 6 dc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 11:** From RS, draw up a loop of F in any dc not a part of a 3-dc group, ch 3, 2 dc in same dc, ch 1, \*sk next 2 ch-1 sps, 3 dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* around, sk last 2 ch-1 sps; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Six 3-dc groups. Fasten off.

**Rnd 12:** From RS, draw up a loop of E in any ch-1 sp, ch 4, \*dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – 6 dc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through sts of last rnd and pull to gather. Knot securely.

# Lower Edging

Working around remaining edge of ring of Squares, work same as Rnds 1-3 of Crown (Top of Hat). Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
