### Hippity Hop Blankie

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 26 x 33 in. (66 x 84 cm).

#### **MATERIALS**

- 860-100 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: White  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Fiberloft Polyester Stuffing 12 oz Bag
- Additional Materials  
Small amount of brown yarn

*\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic  
**400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon  
**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)  
**Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)  
**Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*



#### **GAUGE:**

13 hdc + 11 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**sc2tog (sc dec)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**hdc2tog (hdc dec)** Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

#### **NOTES:**

1. Bunny Head is worked first in rnds, then Blankie is worked in rows.
2. Bunny Ears are worked separately then sewn to Head.

#### **BLANKIE**

##### **Bunny Head**

**Note:** Head is worked in continuous rnds; do not join or turn.

Ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; place marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around – you will have 12 sc at the end of Rnd 2.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnds 6-11:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 12:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc, rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 13:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc, rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 14:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next sc, rep from \* around – 12 sc.

Do not fasten off.

### Blanket

**Note:** You will now be working in rows.

**Row 1:** Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in each of next 6 sts; leave rem sts unworked – 12 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in first st, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st – 14 sts.

Rep Row 2 until you have a total of 76 sts.

**Next Row:** Ch 10, turn, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch and st across – 84 sts.

**Next Row:** Ch 10, turn, hdc in 3rd ch from hook and next 7 ch, hdc in next 76 sts; leave rem sts unworked – 84 sts.

**Next Row:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in next 72 sts, hdc2tog; leave rem sts unworked – 74 sts.

**Next Row:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, hdc2tog – 72 sts.

Rep last row until 4 sts rem.

**Next Row:** Ch 2, turn, (hdc2tog) twice – 2 sts.

Fasten off.

### EARS (make 2)

Ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook; place marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* around – 6 sc.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around – 8 sc.

**Rnd 4:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* around – 10 sc.

**Rnds 5-10:** Sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 11:** (Sc2tog) 5 times – 5 sc.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

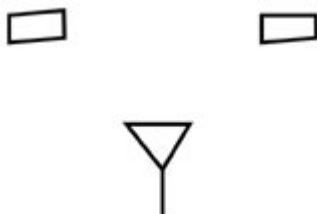
Stuff Head with fiberfill stuffing and sew closed. Sew Ears to top of Head.

#### Edging

From right side, join yarn with sl st in edge of Blankie below Head. Work sc evenly spaced around outside edge of Blankie to opposite side of Head, working 2 sc in each corner.

Knot side corners of Blankie to make paws. With brown yarn and following diagram, embroider straight st eyes, nose and mouth.

Weave in ends.
