• 790-605 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Homespun Yarn: Sand</u>

<u>Dune</u>

1 Ball (A)

• 790-602 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Homespun Yarn: Blue</u> Moon

1 Ball (B)

• 790-600 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Homespun Yarn:</u> Clouds

1 Ball (C)

 790-604 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Homespun Yarn:</u> Forest

1 Ball (D)

<u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>

*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

10 sts + 7 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

cross-dc (crossed dc) Sk next st, dc in next st, dc in skipped st.

Bobble (10 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 9 times (11 loops rem on hook) yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES:

- 1. Shawl is worked first, then hood is worked beg across one long edge of Shawl.
- 2. The last row of the hood is crocheted together, then a long ch and Bobble are worked as trim.
- 3. Before beg, cut a 5 yd. (4.5 m) length of A and set aside for hood Bobble.
- 4. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Continue with new color. Fasten off old color.

SHAWL

With A, ch 37.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 36 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in next st, *cross-dc; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts – 16 cross-dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in next st, *cross-dc; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 3 and 4 six more times.

Change to B.

Rows 17-32: With B, rep Rows 3 and 4 eight times.

Change to C.

Rows 33-52: With C, rep Rows 3 and 4 ten times.

Change to B.

Rows 53-72: With B, rep Rows 3 and 4 ten times.

Change to C.

Rows 73-88: With C, rep Rows 3 and 4 eight times.

Change to D.

Rows 89-104: With D, rep Rows 3 and 4 eight times.

Row 105: With D, rep Row 3.

Row 106: Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across.

Fasten off.

Hood

Place 2 markers on one long side of Shawl, each about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from a corner.

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join D with sl st at first marker, ch 1, work 58 sc evenly spaced across edge to next marker.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next st, *cross-dc; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts – 27 cross-dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in next st, *cross-dc; rep from * to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 3 and 4 six more times.

Change to A.

Rows 17-24: With A, rep Rows 3 and 4 four times.

Joining Row: Fold last row of hood in half; working through both thicknesses, sc in each st across to join top of hood.

With 2 strands of A held tog (working yarn + 5 yd. (4.5 m) length of A set aside earlier), ch 14, work Bobble in 4th ch from hook. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Bobbles (make 6 – 1 each of A and D, and 2 each of B and C)

Note: To work with 2 strands of each color held tog, cut 5 yd. (4.5 m) lengths of each before beginning. With 2 strands of yarn held tog, ch 4, Bobble in 4th ch from hook. Fasten off.

Tie

With 2 strands of A held tog, make a ch about 45 in. (114.5 cm) long. Fasten off. Weave tie through sts of Row 1 of hood (at neck).

Sew a Bobble to each end of tie and to each corner of Shawl.

Weave in ends.
