**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 2 in. (5 cm) in diameter

#### MATERIALS

- 601-620 [Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Pastels](#)  
1 Ball

*\*Bonbons (Article #601).*

**Cotton:** 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Acrylic:** 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Metallic:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: **Cotton:** Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

8 x .35oz/10g  
8 x 28yd/26m

**Acrylic:** Weight Category 3: DK Weight

8 x .35oz/10g  
8 x 28yd/26m

- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Metallic:** Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

8 x .35oz/10g  
8 x 38.3 yd/35m

- Additional Materials  
Fiberfill stuffing



#### GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES:

1. Macaroons are worked in continuous rnds, do not join or turn at the end of each rnd.
2. Color is changed to white for Rnd 7 on each Macaroon.
3. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Do not fasten off original color, carry it across wrong side of piece until next needed.
4. Macaroons are worked at a tight gauge to create a denser fabric that will hide the stuffing.

#### MACAROONS (make 2 of each color except white)

With color of your choice, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook – 6 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is

completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sts.

**Rnd 3:** \*Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 18 sts.

**Rnd 4:** \*Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 24 sts.

**Rnd 5:** Rep Rnd 3 – 36 sts.

**Rnd 6:** Sc in each st around, changing to white in last st – 36 sts.

Do not fasten off original color.

### **Filling**

**Rnd 7:** With white, ch 2, working through the back loops only, hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Fasten off white.

**Rnd 8:** With original color, sl st in each st around.

**Rnd 9:** Working through the back loops only, sc in each st around.

**Rnd 10:** Working through both loops, \*sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 27 sts.

**Rnd 11:** \*Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, sc in next st, sc2tog – 20 sts.

Stuff Macaroon firmly with fiberfill stuffing.

**Rnd 12:** Sc2tog around – 10 sts.

**Rnd 13:** Sc2tog around – 5 sts.

**Rnd 14:** Sc2tog twice, sc in last st.

Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
