CORRECTIONS: (applied Apr 2, 2015)

Princess Overskirt

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Rnds 7-9: ~~Rep Rnd 5.~~ **Ch 11 (counts as first dc, ch 8), dc in next dc, *ch 8, dc in next dc; rep from * around, ch 8; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-11.**

Fasten off.

Join dark blue yarn from yarn package D with a sl st in last st of Rnd 9.

Rnds 10-13: ~~Rep Rnd 5.~~ **Rnd 7.**

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

GAUGE:

18 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with any yarn from yarn package C.
EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Princess and Daytime dolls are joined – just flip the skirt to reveal the dolls, one at a time.
2. Doll Head/Body is worked in the rnd in 2 halves – Princess half and Daytime half.
3. Skirts are worked beginning directly on the doll bodies. 4. Arms are worked separately, then sewn on.
5. Additional details are worked separately.
6. Facial features are embroidered with simple straight sts.
7. For C and D yarns, pattern provides specific colors, but always feel free to use the C and D colors of your choice.

HEAD/BODY

Princess Half of Doll

Beginning with white yarn from yarn package C, ch 2.

Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker (pm) in the first sc and move marker up as work progresses.

Rnd 1: Work 2 sc in each sc around – you will have 12 sc at the end of Rnd 1.

Rnd 2: *2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in first sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 5: *2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 6-10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 11: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 12: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 13: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 14: Sc in each sc around.

Begin stuffing the head, continue to stuff as work progresses.

Rnd 15: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 16: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * around – 21 sc.

Fasten off.

Join light blue yarn from yarn package C with a sl st in last st of Rnd 16.

Rnd 17: *2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnds 18-24: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

Join dark blue yarn from yarn package D with a sl st in last st of Rnd 24.

Rnds 25-27: Sc in each sc around – 24 sc.

Fasten off.

Daytime Half of Doll

Join dark green yarn from yarn package D with a sl st in last st of Rnd 27.

Rnds 28-30: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

Join light green yarn from yarn package C with a sl st in last st of Rnd 30.

Rnds 31-38: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 39: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * around – 21 sc.

Fasten off.

Join light pink yarn from yarn package C with a sl st in last st of Rnd 39.

Don't forget to continue to stuff!

Rnd 40: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 41: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 42: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 43: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 44: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 45-49: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 50: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 51: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 52: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 53: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Finish stuffing the head.

Rnd 54: Sc2tog around – 6 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and draw through last 6 sc, pull to gather and knot securely.

Daytime Doll Skirt

Join A with a sl st anywhere on Rnd 27 of Daytime Doll Head/Body.

Rnd 1: Sc in each st around – 24 sc.

Pm in first st, move marker up as work progresses.

Rnd 2: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 3: *2 hdc in next sc, hdc in next 5 sc; rep from * around – 35 hdc.

Rnd 4: *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 6 hdc; rep from * around – 40 hdc.

Rnd 5: *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 7 hdc; rep from * around – 45 hdc.

Rnd 6: *2 hdc in first hdc, hdc in the next 8 hdc; rep from * around – 50 hdc.

Rnd 7: *2 hdc in first hdc, hdc in the next 9 hdc; rep from * around – 55 hdc.

Rnd 8: *2 hdc in first hdc, hdc in the next 10 hdc; rep from * around – 60 hdc.

Rnds 9-19: Hdc in each hdc around.

Rnd 20: Sc in each hdc around, join with sl st in beg sc.

Fasten off.

Princess Skirt

Note: Skirt is worked with 2 strands of B. Wind B into 2 balls before beginning.

Join 2 strands of B with a sl st anywhere on Rnd 28 of Princess Head/Body.

Rnd 1: With 2 strands of B held tog, sc in each st around – 24 sc.

Pm in first st, move marker up as work progresses.

Rep Rnds 2-20 of Daytime Doll Skirt.

Do NOT fasten off.

Join Skirts

With 2 strands of B held tog, ch 1, working through both skirts, *work 3 sc all in the next st, sk next st; rep from * around entire lower edge.

Join with sl st in beg sc.

Fasten off.

Princess Overskirt

Join light blue yarn from yarn package D with a sl st anywhere on Rnd 26 of Princess Head/Body.

Rnd 1: Sc in each st around – 24 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in beg ch-3 – 32 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in the next dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * around; join with sl st in beg ch-3 – 40 dc and 8 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, *dc in next 5 dc, ch 2, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2; rep from * to last 2 dc, dc in last 2 dc; join with sl st in beg ch-3 – 48 dc and 16 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 5: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next dc, ch 5, sk next dc, dc in next dc, *ch 5, sk next dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 5, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * 6 more times, ch 5, sk next dc, dc in next dc; join with sl st in beg ch-3 – 32 dc and 16 ch-5 sps.

Rnd 6: Ch 11 (counts as first dc, ch 8), sk next dc, dc in the next dc, *ch 8, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * around *, ch 8; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-11 – 16 dc and 16 ch-8 sps.

Rnds 7-9: Ch 11 (counts as first dc, ch 8), dc in next dc, *ch 8, dc in next dc; rep from * around, ch 8; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-11.

Fasten off.

Join dark blue yarn from yarn package D with a sl st in last st of Rnd 9.

Rnds 10-13: Rep Rnd 7.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, work 8 dc in each ch-sp around.

Join with sl st in beg dc.

Fasten off.

PRINCESS ARMS (make 2)

With white yarn from yarn package C, ch 2.

Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker (pm) in the first sc and move marker up as work progresses.

Rnd 1: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnd 2: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 6 sc.

Rnds 4-7: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

Join light blue yarn from yarn package C with a sl st in last st of Rnd 7.

Rnd 8: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnd 9: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 6 sc.

Rnd 10 : Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

DAYTIME DOLL ARMS (make 2)

Make same as Princess Arms, beginning with light pink yarn from yarn package C, then changing to light green yarn from yarn package D.

PRINCESS TIARA

With light blue yarn from yarn package C, ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch, ch 4, sk next 3 ch, sc in last 3 ch – 6 sc and 1 ch-4 sp.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk first 3 sc, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) all into the ch-4 sp, sk next 2 sc, sl st in last sc, ch 20 and sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

DAYTIME DOLL KERCHIEF

With dark green yarn from yarn package D, ch 22.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to last 2 ch, sc2tog in last 2 ch – 20 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog over last 2 sc – 19 sc.

Rep Row 2 until you have only 1 sc remaining.

Fasten off.

Join yarn with a sl st in one end of Row 1 and ch 20.

Join with sl st into opposite end of Row 1.

Fasten off.

DAYTIME DOLL APRON

With light blue yarn from yarn package C, ch 16.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 15 sc.

Rows 2-10: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, *sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * twice more – 12 sc.

Row 12: Ch1, turn, *sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * twice more – 9 sc.

Rows 13-20: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Fasten off.

Apron Strings

Join white yarn from yarn package C with a sl st in one end of Row 20 of Apron.

Ch 16, sl st into end of Row 13, ch 30.

Fasten off.

Make a second apron string at opposite end of Row 20.

PATCHES FOR DAYTIME DOLL (make 5, or as desired)

With color as desired, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 4 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

HAIR (make 2)

With yellow yarn from yarn package C, wrap yarn around the cardboard about 40 times. Slip a length of matching yarn under the strands at one edge and tie.

Cut the strands at the edge opposite the knot.

With the tie as the center part of hair, glue hair to one doll head and allow to dry.

Rep to make hair for second doll.

Hair Styling

For Daytime Doll, tie hair into a loose ponytail with a strand of any color yarn.

For Princess Doll, tie hair loosely in back, then loop end of ponytail back up and tie in place to make more of an "up do" looking hairstyle.

FINISHING

Sew arms to each doll, just below head.

Face

With A, make a few straight sts on each doll head for eyes. With red yarn from yarn package D, or color of your choice, embroider a straight st smile on each doll.

Attach the tiara to the Princess by looping the chain around the back of her head. Sew a few sts through the chain to secure.

Attach the kerchief to the Daytime Doll in the same way.

Sew patches as desired onto the Daytime Doll's skirt.

Slip the chain loops of the Apron over the Daytime Doll's arms and tie ends in back of doll.

Weave in ends.
