- 601-620 [Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Pastels](#)

1 Ball

**Bonbons (Article #601).*

Cotton: 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

1 Ball

Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package

GAUGE:

12 sts (four 3-dc groups) + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

NOTES:

1. Shawl is worked in rows with RS facing at all times.
2. Color is changed on every row. Fasten off old color and join new color to beg ch of row to beg next row.

COLORS

White (A)

SHAWL

With A, ch 5.

Row 1 (RS): (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1, dc) in 5th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc, ch 1) – Two 3-dc groups at the end of this row. Fasten off.

Row 2: From RS, join B with sl st in 4th ch of beg ch, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), 3 dc in first ch-1 sp (formed by beg ch of previous row), ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in last dc – Four 3-dc groups at the end of this row. Fasten off.

Row 3: From RS, join C with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch of previous row, ch 4, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 2 times, ch 1, dc in last dc – Six 3-dc groups at the end of this row. Fasten off.

Row 4: From RS, join D with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch of previous row, ch 4, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 2 times, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in last dc – Eight 3-dc groups at the end of this row. Fasten off.

Row 5: From RS, join E with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch of previous row, ch 4, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, **ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** across, ch 1, dc in last dc – Ten 3-dc groups at the end of this row. Fasten off.

Rows 6-26: Rep last rnd 21 more times, changing color as in following color sequence: Work 1 row each with F, A, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I – Fifty-two 3-dc groups at the end of Row 26. Fasten off.

Row 27: From RS, join J with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch of previous row, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), hdc in first ch-1 sp, hdc in each st and ch-1 sp to center ch-2 sp, (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in center ch-2 sp, hdc in each st and ch-1 sp across, ch 1, hdc in last dc – 214 hdc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp. Fasten off.

Row 28: From RS, join K with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch of previous row, ch 3, hdc in first ch-1 sp, hdc in each hdc to center ch-2 sp, (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in center ch-2 sp, hdc in each st to last ch-1 sp, hdc in last ch-1 sp, ch 1, hdc in last st – 220 hdc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp. Fasten off.

Row 29: From RS, join L with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch of previous row, ch 3, hdc in first ch-1 sp, hdc in each st to center ch-2 sp, 4 hdc in center ch-2 sp, place a marker in the sp between the center 2 hdc of the 4-hdc just made to indicate center point, hdc in each st to last ch-1 sp, hdc in last ch-1 sp, ch 1, hdc in last st – 226 hdc, and 2 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Row 30: From RS, join M with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch, ch 5, sl st in first ch-1 sp, *ch 5, sk next 2 sts, sl st in next st; rep from * to 2 sts before last ch-1 sp, ch 5, sk next 2 sts, sl st in last ch-1 sp, ch 5, sl st in last hdc – 77 ch-5 sps. Fasten off. Move center point marker to ch-5 sp over center point.

Row 31: From RS, join N with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch, ch 5, sl st in first ch-sp, *ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across working last sl st in last ch-5 sp, ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch of last ch-5 sp – 78 ch-5 sps. Fasten off. Move center point marker to ch-5 sp over center point.

Row 32: From RS, join O with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch, ch 5, sl st in first ch-sp, *ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across to center point, ch 7, sl st in next ch-5 sp, **ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp; rep from ** across working last sl st in last ch-5 sp, ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch of last ch-5 sp – 79 ch-sps. Fasten off. Remove center point marker.

Row 33: From RS, join P with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch, ch 5, sl st in first ch-sp, *ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across to center ch-7 sp, ch 5, (sl st, ch 5, sl st) in center ch-7 sp, **ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp; rep from ** across working last sl st in last ch-5 sp, ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch of last ch-5 sp – 81 ch-sps. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
