## Lion Brand® Fettuccini®

### Drop Stitch Top

Pattern Number: L40662

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy + (Level 3)

**SIZE:** Adult (Multiple Sizes)

S (M/L, 1X/2X)

**Finished Bust** 34 1/2 (42, 50 1/2) in. (87.5 (106.5, 128.5) cm)

**Finished Length** 22 in. (56 cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- 752-100 Lion Brand Fettuccini Yarn:

Assorted

3 6, 6 Balls EACH OF 3 DIFFERENT  
COLORS

*\*Fettuccini® (Article #752). 100% undetermined fibers - textile by-products ; package size: 11.00oz/312.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins*

- Lion Brand Size 15 [10 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles

- Lion Brand Stitch Holders

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 15 (10 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long



#### GAUGE:

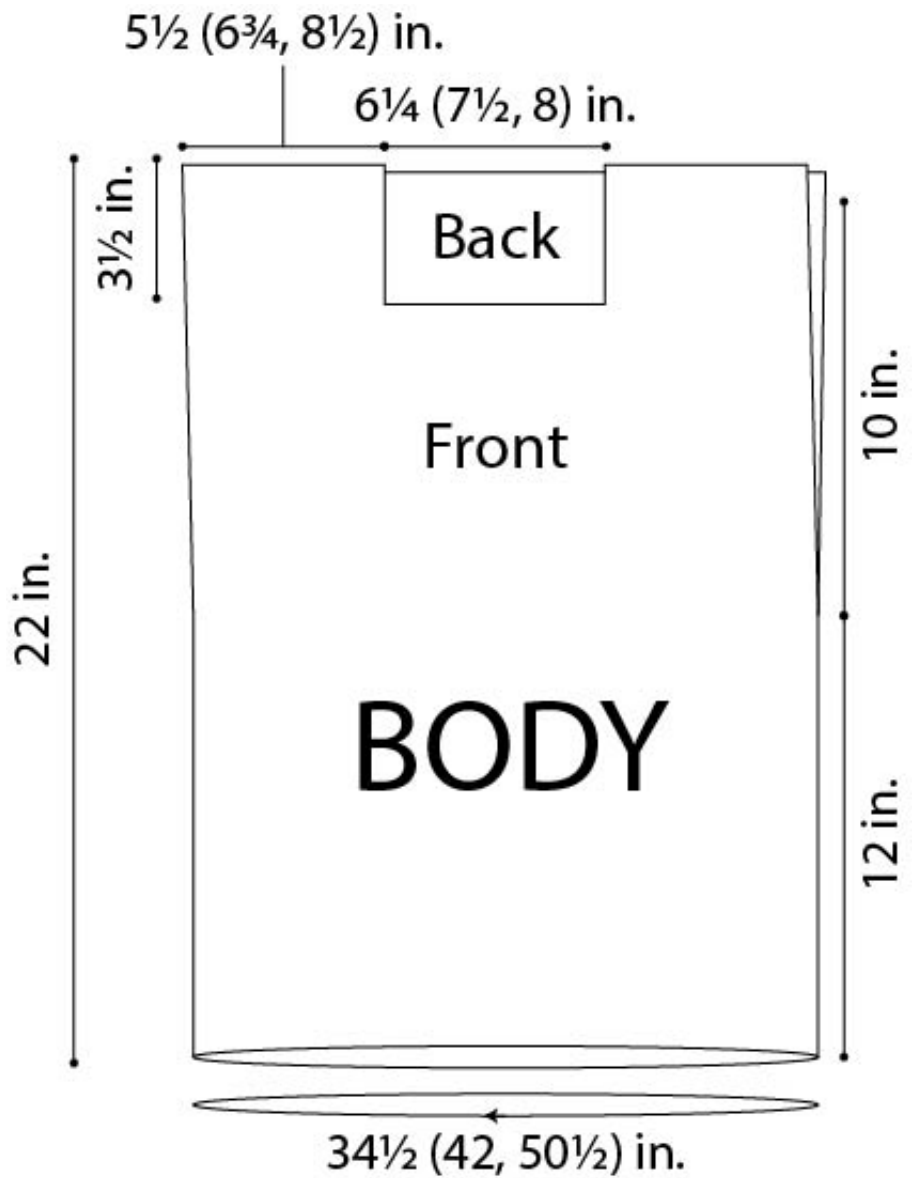
6 1/2 sts + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Drop Stitch pattern of Body.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

1. For this design, label your 3 colors of yarn as A, B and C.
2. Top is worked in one piece in the round to armholes, then divided and Front and Back are worked separately back and forth in rows.
3. Top is worked in a Drop Stitch pattern, changing yarn color to make stripes.



## BODY

With longer circular needle and A, cast on 56 (68, 82) sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Purl 1 rnd.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, k1, \*yo, k1; rep from \* around – you will have 111 (135, 163) sts at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** With A, knit all sts, dropping all yos – 56 (68, 82) sts.

**Rnd 3:** With A, knit.

**Rnd 4:** With A, purl.

Change to B.

**Rnds 5 and 6:** With B, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

**Rnd 7:** With B, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 8:** With B, knit.

Change to C.

**Rnds 9 and 10:** With C, rep Rnds 3 and 4.

Change to B.

**Rnds 11-14:** With B, rep Rnds 5-8.

Change to C.

**Rnds 15 and 16:** With C, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Change to A.

**Rnds 17 and 18:** With A, rep Rnds 3 and 4.

Change to C.

**Rnds 19-22:** Rep Rnds 15-18, changing color as instructed.

Continue with A.

**Rnds 23 and 24:** With A, rep Rnds 1 and 2.

### **Divide for Armholes**

**Rnd 25:** With A, k28 (34, 41), sl remaining 28 (34, 41) sts to a holder.

Sts on the holder are for the front, the 28 (34, 41) sts still on the needle are for back.

### **Back**

Work back and forth in rows over 28 (34, 41) back sts only, working on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

**Row 26 (WS):** With A, knit.

Change to B.

**Row 27:** With B, k1, \*yo, k1; rep from \* to end of row – 55 (67, 81) sts.

**Row 28:** With B, purl all sts and drop all yos – 28 (34, 41) sts.

**Row 29:** With B, k1, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 30:** With B, purl.

Change to C.

**Rows 31 and 32:** With C, knit.

Change to B.

**Rows 33-36:** With B, rep Rows 27-30.

Change to C.

**Rows 37 and 38:** With C, rep Rows 27 and 28.

Change to A.

**Rows 39 and 40:** With A, knit.

Change to C.

**Rows 41-44:** Rep Rows 37-40, changing color as instructed.

Bind off.

### **Front**

Return the 28 (34, 41) front sts from holder to needle.

From RS, join A at beg of sts. Work back and forth in rows over front sts only, working on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

**Row 25 (RS):** With A, knit.

**Rows 26-36:** Work same as Rows 26-36 of Back.

### **Shape Neck**

**Note:** Wind A and C into 2 separate balls before beginning this section.

**Row 37:** With C, k1, \*yo, k1; rep from \* to end of row – 28 (34, 41) sts.

**Row 38 (WS):** As you work this row, purl all of sts as instructed and drop all the yos.

With C, p9 (11, 14) for one side of neck, join a 2nd ball of C and bind off center 10 (12, 13) sts, p9 (11, 14) for other side of neck – 9 (11, 14) sts on each side.

You will now work both sides AT THE SAME TIME using separate balls of yarn.

Change to A.

**Rows 39 and 40:** With A, knit across first side; join a 2nd ball of A at beg of sts of 2nd side and knit across 2nd side.

Change to C.

**Row 41:** With C, k1, \*yo, k1; rep from \* across first side; join a second ball of C at beg of sts of 2nd side and work same as first side – 17 (21, 27) sts on each side.

**Row 42:** With C, purl all sts and drop all yos across each side – 9 (11, 14) sts on each side.

Change to A.

**Rows 43 and 44:** With A, knit across each side.

Bind off each side.

### **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams.

### **Neckband**

From RS, with shorter circular needle and B, pick up and k40 (45, 47) sts as evenly spaced as possible around neck

edge. Join to work in the rnd by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Without working any rows or rnds, bind off all sts.

### **Armhole Edging**

From RS, with shorter circular needle and A, pick up and k38 sts as evenly spaced as possible around one armhole edge. Join to work in the rnd by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Without working any rows or rnds, bind off all sts.

Rep around other armhole.

Weave in ends.
