### MATERIALS

- 792-302 [Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick Yarn: Colonial](#)  
1 Ball

*\*Homespun Thick & Quick (Article #792).  
88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size:  
8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins*

### GAUGE:

11 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in K2, p2 Rib.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### PATTERN STITCH

**K2, p2 Rib (worked over a multiple of 4 sts + 2 additional sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K2, p2 Rib.

### NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in an easy rib pattern.
2. Stitches are divided to work a slit opening, then rejoined to finish the Scarf.
3. The opening allows you to wrap the Scarf around your neck, threading the ends through the

opening.

4. When you see 'as established' in the instructions, this means to continue in the current pattern st.

## SCARF

Cast on 30 sts.

Beg with Row 1, work in K2, p2 rib until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beginning, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

**Dividing Row (RS):** Work 15 sts in K2, p2 rib for right side of keyhole; slip remaining sts to a stitch holder for left side of opening.

Continue in K2, p2 rib until right side of opening measures about 6 in. (15 cm), end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Cut yarn and slip these sts onto a holder.

Return sts for left side of opening onto needle, ready to work a RS row.

Join yarn and work in K2, p2 rib as established until left side of opening measures same as right side, end with a RS row as the last row you work. Do not cut yarn.

**Joining Row (WS):** Work in K2, p2 rib as established across sts on needle; return sts from holder to left hand needle and continue in K2, p2 rib across – you will have 30 sts at the end of this row.

Work in K2, p2 rib as established over these 30 sts until about 1 yd. (1 m) of yarn remains.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
