**MATERIALS**

- 861-170 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: *\*Vanna's Glamour (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins*  
Topaz  
1 Ball (A)
- 601-660 Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn:  
Celebrate  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size E-4 (3.5 mm)  
*\*Bonbons (Article #601). 100% Cotton. Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.*
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)  
*100% Acrylic. Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.*
- Darice® Plastic Canvas Star Shapes (10 pcs)  
*96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 28yd/26m*
- Additional Materials  
Wood dowel, 3/8 in. (10 mm) diameter, 18 in. (45.5 cm) long  
Purchased fabric covered headband  
Assorted sew or glue on beads and jewels, as desired  
Craft glue  
Sewing needle and thread  
*Weight Category 3: DK Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 28yd/26m*  
*Weight Category 2: Sport Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 38.3 yd/35m*



**GAUGE:**

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

**NOTES:**

1. Precut plastic canvas stars are embroidered, then sewn together and glued to Wand.
2. Embroidery is worked with simple stitches. Follow the stitch guide for how to work the stitches and follow the chart for stitch placement and yarn colors.
3. Headband is wrapped with yarn and finished with cord and embellishments.
4. We encourage you to be creative and use yarn colors as desired!

**WAND**

**Stars (make 2)  
Embroidery**

**Notes:**

1. Use a doubled strand of yarn threaded into blunt needle for embroidery.
2. Leave the border thread around the outside edge of the star unworked.

**Colors for B yarns**

- Pink (C)
- Purple (D)
- Green (E)

**Center**

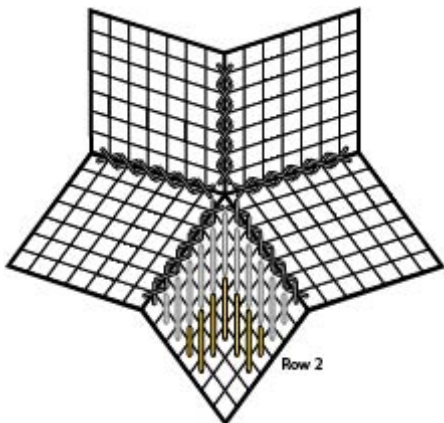
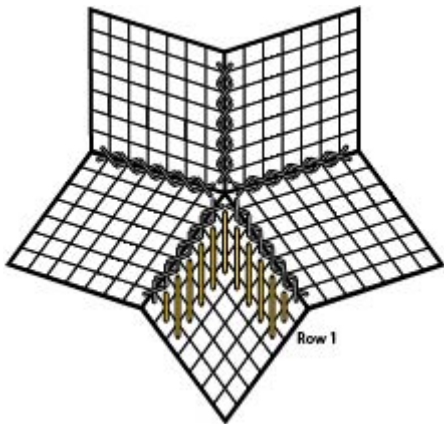
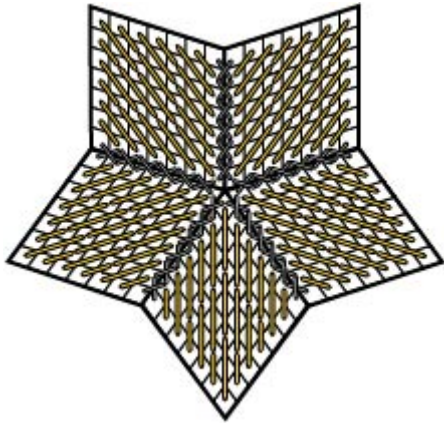
With C and following chart, work cross stitches over the 5 threads between star segments.

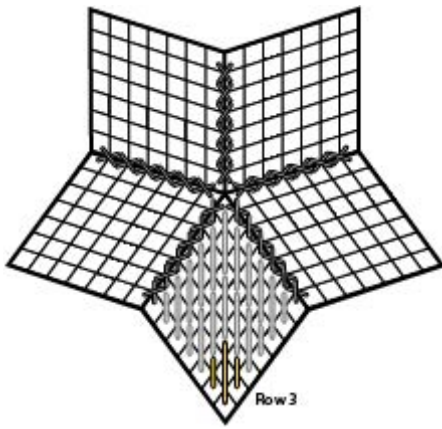
**Note:** For Rows 1-3, the first and last stitches of each row are worked over only 1 intersection of threads.

**Row 1:** With A and following chart, work straight stitches over 2 intersecting threads.

**Row 2:** With A and following chart, work straight stitches over the next 2 intersecting threads.

**Row 3:** With A and following chart, work straight stitches over the remaining intersections.





X With C, work Cross stitch

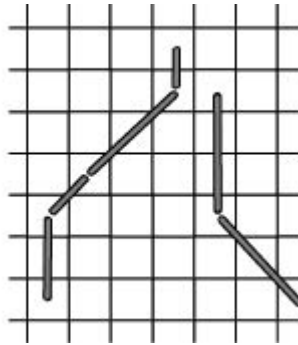
| With A, work Straight stitch over 2 intersections of threads

**Cross Stitch** - This stitch is worked over an intersection of threads. Each stitch is worked completely before going on to the next. The direction of the top stitch may vary, but all stitches on a stitched piece should be made in the same direction.



**Straight Stitch** - This stitch can cover one or more intersections or threads and can be vertical, horizontal, or slant in either direction.



## Handle

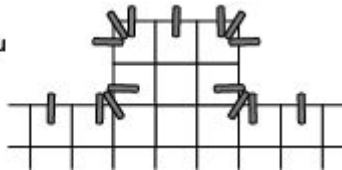
Cut 3 strands of B yarn in colors as desired, each length about 3 yds. (3 m) long. Hold 3 strands together and glue ends to one end of dowel, about 2 in. (5 cm) from dowel end. Wrap strands around to opposite end of dowel then trim ends and glue to dowel.

## FINISHING

### Assembly

Hold the 2 stars with wrong sides together. With a double strand of D threaded into blunt needle, work overcast stitch around outside edge through both stars, leaving a small opening at one inside corner for handle. Apply glue to unwrapped end of dowel and insert into opening on star.

**Overcast Stitch** - This stitch is used to cover the edge of the canvas or to join pieces of canvas. You may need to go through the same hole more than once to get even coverage on the edge, especially at the corners.



### Streamers

With crochet hook and B yarn in color as desired, chain for about 18 in. (45.5 cm). Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then draw needle through edge of star. Knot, then draw needle through to inside of star and back out. Trim yarn end of yarn tail. Make and attach 4 more streamers, varying the lengths from 10-18 in. (25.5-45.5 cm).

**Embellishment**

Sew or glue beads and jewels to Wand as desired.

**HEADBAND**

Glue one end of B yarn in color as desired to one end of Headband. Wrap yarn around until you reach the opposite end of the headband. Trim excess yarn, then glue end to Headband.

**Twisted Cord**

Cut a 5 yd. (5 m) length of A. Fold length in half and knot about 1 in. (2.5 cm) from each end. Slip one end over a doorknob and slip a pencil or chop stick through the other end.

Turn the pencil to twist the strands clockwise until they are tightly twisted. Keeping the strands taut, fold the piece in half, remove the pencil and allow the cord to twist on itself.

Fold twisted cord in half. Glue the center of the cord to the inside of one end of Headband. Wrap cord around Headband, crossing the cord ends as you wrap. Glue end of cord to Headband.

**Embellishment**

Glue or sew on beads and sequins as desired.
