# SCARF

**Dinosaur Head** 

#### Neck

Row 13: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 13 until piece measures about 49 in. (117 cm) from beginning, end with a  $\frac{1}{100}$  RS row as the last row you work.

# Shape Body

Row 1 (RS WS): Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st across – 16 sts.

- Additional Materials Small amount of black yarn Small amount of red yarn

#### GAUGE:

11 hdc + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

# hdc2tog (hdc dec)

Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

# Surface Chain Stitch

Thread needle and bring from back to front through Scarf. \*Hold short length of yarn on front, forming a small loop. Insert needle back into where it last came out, do not pull tight. Bring needle back through Scarf and through small loop; repeat from \* until chain is desired length.

# NOTES:

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece.
- 2. Dinosaur feet, spots and eyes are worked separately and sewn to Scarf.

# SCARF

# **Dinosaur Head**

With A, ch 17.

**Row 1 (RS):** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as hdc) and in each ch across – 16 hdc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (always counts as first hdc), turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc each st to last st, 2 hdc in last st – you will have 18 hdc at the end of Row 2.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Row 2 – 22 sts at the end of Row 4.

Row 5: Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st across – 23 sts.

Row 6: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.

Row 7: Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across – 22 sts.

Row 8: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in last st – 21 sts.

Rows 9 and 10: Rep Rows 7 and 8 – 19 sts at the end of Row 10.

Row 11: Rep Row 7 – 18 sts.

Row 12: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 14 sts, leave remaining sts unworked – 15 sts.

### Neck

Row 13: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 13 until piece measures about 49 in. (117 cm) from beginning, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

# Shape Body

Row 1 (WS): Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st across – 16 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st to last st, 2 hdc in last st – 17 sts.

Row 3: Ch 9, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 7 ch, hdc in each st across – 25 sts.

Rows 4 and 5: Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st across – 27 sts at the end of Row 5.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 2 – 28 sts.

**Row 7:** Rep Row 4 – 29 sts.

Row 8: Rep Row 2 - 30 sts.

Row 9: Ch 8, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 7 ch, sc in each st across – 37 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to last st, sl st in last st.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sk next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each st to end of row.
Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc to last 6 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, sl st in last st – 39 sts.
Row 13: Rep Row 11.
Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Feet (make 2)

With B, ch 7.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as hdc) and in each ch across – 6 sts.

Fasten off. Join A with a sl st in last st of Row 1. Rows 2 and 3: With A, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in each st across. Fasten off. Sew feet to lower edge of dinosaur body. Large Spots (make 2) With B, ch 2. Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st, move marker up as each rnd is completed. Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around -12 sc. **Rnd 3:** \*Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc – 18 sc. Fasten off. Medium Spots (make 2) With B, ch 2. Rep Rnds 1 and 2 of large spot. Join with sl st in first st. Fasten off. Small Spots (make 2) With B, ch 2. Rep Rnd 1 of large spot. Join with sl st in first st. Fasten off. Eyes (make 2) With black yarn, ch 2. Rep Rnd 1 of large spot. Join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Sew spots and eyes to dinosaur on both sides of Scarf. With red yarn, embroider a Surface Chain st mouth on both sides of Scarf. Weave in ends.
