Lion Brand® Bonbons Necklace in Bloom

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SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE:

About 60 in. (152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 601-640 [Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Nature](#)
1 Ball (A)
**Bonbons (Article #601).*
Cotton: 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.
Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.
- 601-660 [Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Celebrate](#)
1 Ball (B)
Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: **Cotton:** Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

Metallic: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight
8 x .35oz/10g
8 x 38.3 yd/35m



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Dc-Cl (double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over, insert hook in same st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

Tr-Cl (triple (treble) crochet cluster) (Yarn over) 2 times, insert hook in indicated ch and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 2 times, *(yarn over) 2 times, insert hook in same ch and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 2 times; rep from * once more, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES:

Chain and Flowers are worked separately, then Flowers are sewn to the Chain.

CHAIN

With green yarn from A, ch 5, *tr-Cl in 5th ch from hook, ch 3, sl st in top of tr-Cl just made, ch 5, sl st in ch at base of same tr-Cl, (ch 10, sl st in 5th ch from hook) 3 times, ch 10; rep from * 15 more times; ch 5, sl st in ch at base of same tr-Cl.

Fasten off.

Join green yarn from B with a sl st in base of last tr-Cl, sl st in each ch across.

Fasten off.

FLOWERS

Notes

1. Use yarn colors as desired for Flowers.
2. We made 16 Flowers – feel free to make as many as you like! Flower 1 With any color, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each sc across – 6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, work 2 sc in each sc across – 12 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, work 2 sc in each sc across – 24 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Fasten off.

Coil piece into a spiral, sew a few sts through base of flower.

Flower 2

With any color, ch 5, join with a sl st to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 10 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join a 2nd color with a sl st in any sc, *ch 3, dc-Cl in next sc, ch 3, sl st in top of dc-CL, ch 3, sl st in next sc; rep from * around.

Fasten off.

Flower 3

With any color, ch 5, join with a sl st to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 10 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join a 2nd color with a sl st in any sc, *ch 5, sl st in next sc; rep from * around.

Fasten off.

Flower 4

With any color, ch 5, join with a sl st to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 5 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join a 2nd color with a sl st in any sc, *ch 3, dc-Cl in same st, ch 3, sl st in same st; rep from * around.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Flowers onto Chain as desired.

Weave in ends.
