SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: Child (Multiple Sizes)

Child's S (M, L)

Finished Circumference About 16 (17 1/2, 19) in. (40.5 (44.5, 48.5) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished Length About 6 1/2 (7, 7 1/2) in. (16.5 (18, 19) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 136-103 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Denali
1 1, 1 Ball (A)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Heartland (Article #136). Solids: 100% Acrylic*

Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)

Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)



GAUGE:

12 sc + 15 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Hat is worked in one piece in the rnd.

HAT

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 5 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, work 2 sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc – 10 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 15 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 20 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 25 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 30 sc.

Rnd 7: Rep Rnd 6 – 36 sc.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 42 sc.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 48 sc.

Sizes M (L) ONLY

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in first 11 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 52 sc.

Size L ONLY

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc; rep from * to last 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 6 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 56 sc.

ALL SIZES

Rnds 10-25 (11-26, 12-27): Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc – 48 (52, 56) sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
