#### SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

MATERIALS • 601-610 <u>Lion</u>	* <u>Bonbons</u> (Article #601). <b>Cotton:</b> 100% Cotton. <b>Care:</b> Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene. <b>Acrylic:</b> 100% Acrylic. <b>Care:</b> Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not
<u>Brand Bonbons</u> <u>Yarn: Brights</u> 2 Balls (A)	Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.
Gollis (A)	Metallic:96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester.Care: MachineWash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, DryClean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size:Cotton:Weight Category 2: Sport Weight8 x .350z/10g
Lion Brand Crochet Hook -	8 x 28yd/26m
<u>Size H-8 (5 mm)</u>	Acrylic: Weight Category 3: DK Weight
Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt	8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 28yd/26m
<u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>	<i>Metallic:</i> Weight Category 2: Sport Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 38.3 yd/35m

## GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

#### NOTES:

56 Squares are worked individually, then strung onto crocheted chains to make the Garland.
When instructed to work with A or B, use any color of your choice from the indicated package of Bonbons. All pieces are made with 2 strands of yarn held tog. You can use 2 strands of the same color or one strand each of 2 different colors, whichever you like!

# LARGE SQUARE (make 8)

With 2 strands of any color of A held tog, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. **Rnd 1:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times, 2 dc in ring; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg

ch – at the end of Rnd 1 you will have 4 ch-2 sps and 12 dc.

**Rnd 2:** SI st in first ch-sp, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), 2 dc in same ch-sp, \*dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, dc in each dc to first ch-sp, dc in first ch-sp; join with sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 28 dc (7 dc across each of 4 sides). **Rnd 3:** Rep Rnd 2 – 4 ch-2 sps and 44 dc (11 dc across each of 4 sides). Fasten off.

# ONE COLOR MEDIUM SQUARES (make 18)

**Note:** Make 6 Squares with 2 strands of A held tog, 6 Squares with 2 strands of B held tog, and 6 Squares with 1 strand each of A and B held tog.

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnds 1 and 2: Work same as Rnds 1 and 2 of Large Square.

Fasten off.

## TWO COLOR MEDIUM SQUARES (make 6)

With 2 strands of A held tog, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Work same as Rnd 1 of Large Square.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** From RS, join 2 strands of B with sl st in first ch-sp, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), 2 dc in same ch-sp, \*dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, dc in each dc to first ch-sp, dc in first ch-sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – 4 ch-2 sps and 28 dc (7 dc across each of 4 sides).

Fasten off.

## SMALL SQUARES (make 24)

**Note:** Make 6 Squares with 2 strands of A held tog, 6 Squares with 2 strands of B held tog, and 12 Squares with 1 strand each of A and B held tog.

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. **Rnd 1:** Work same as Rnd 1 of Large Square.

Fasten off.

# GARLANDS (make 4)

**Note:** Make each Garland with 2 strands of any of the yarns held tog.

Ch 12; join with sl st in first ch to make the first hanging loop, then chain until piece measures about 33 in. (84 cm) from beg, then sl st in 13th ch from hook. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Make a pile of 14 Squares arranged (from bottom to top of the pile) in the following order: Large Square (Small Square, Medium Square) 3 times Large Square (Small Square, Medium Square) 3 times

String Squares onto the Garland by working from the top to bottom of the pile as follows: Weave Garland in and out of ch-2 sps diagonally across each Square. Rep with remaining Garlands and Squares. Weave in ends.
