# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Unique Shaded Keyhole Scarf

Pattern Number: L50033

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 5 1/2 x 41 in. (14 x 104 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 755-203 Lion Brand Unique Yarn: Passion Fruit  
2 Balls  
*\*Unique (Article #755). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (109yds/100m) pull skeins*
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



### GAUGE:

26 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in K2, p2 Rib.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### PATTERN STITCH

**K2, p2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts + 2 additional sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts as they face you.

Rep Row 2 for K2, p2 Rib.

### NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in K2, p2 Rib.
2. Stitches are divided to make a keyhole opening, then rejoined to finish the Scarf.
3. Keyhole opening is worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

## SCARF

Cast on 38 sts.

Work in K2, p2 Rib until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beginning, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

### Keyhole Opening

**Dividing Row (RS):** \*K1, slip next st to st holder; rep from \* to end of row – 19 sts on needle and 19 sts on holder.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Continue in St st (k on RS, p on WS) on 19 sts for 3 in. (7.5 cm). Cut yarn and slip these 19 sts to a 2nd st holder.

Slip 19 sts from first holder back onto needle, join yarn and work in St st for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

**Joining Row:** \*K1 from needle, k1 from st holder; rep from \* to end of row – 38 sts.

Continue in K2, p2 Rib on 38 sts until piece measures about 41 in. (104 cm) from beginning.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
