MATERIALS

- 931-200 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Sun Rays
3 Balls (A)
- 931-201 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Meadow Flowers
2 Balls (B)
- 931-202 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Enchanted Forest
2 Balls (C)
- 931-203 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Arctic Sky
2 Balls (D)
- 931-204 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Ocean Waves
2 Balls (E)
- 931-205 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Mountain Dawn
2 Balls (F)
- 931-206 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Mystical Moors
2 Balls (G)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 [5 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Textures (Article #931). 90% Acrylic, 10% Nylon; package size: 3.00oz/85.05 gr. (149yds/136m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

17 sts + 28 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).
1 Square = about 6 3/4 x 6 3/4 in. (17 x 17 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern

and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

NOTES:

1. 48 Squares are worked separately, then sewn together following a diagram.
2. Squares are worked in Garter st (knit every row) from corner to corner, increasing and decreasing to make the Square.



SQUARE I (make 8)

With A, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, M1, k1, M1, k1 – you will have 5 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3 (Increase – RS): K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 7 sts.

Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 four times – 15 sts at the end of Row 11.

Row 12: Knit.

Change to B.

Row 13: With B, rep Row 3 – 17 sts.

Rows 14-35: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3 eleven times – 39 sts at the end of Row 35.

Row 36: Knit.

Row 37 (Decrease – RS): K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 37 sts.

Rows 38-57: Rep Rows 36 and 37 ten times – 17 sts at the end of Row 57.

Row 58: Knit.

Change to A.

Row 59: Rep Row 37 – 15 sts.

Rows 60-69: Rep Rows 36 and 37 five times – 5 sts at the end of Row 69.

Row 70: Knit.

Row 71: K1, k3tog, k1 – 3 sts.

Bind off.

SQUARE II (make 8)

Make same as Square I working Rows 1-12 with A, Rows 13-58 with C, and Rows 59-71 with A.

SQUARE III (make 8)

Make same as Square I working Rows 1-12 with A, Rows 13-58 with D, and Rows 59-71 with A.

SQUARE IV (make 8)

Make same as Square I working Rows 1-12 with A, Rows 13-58 with E, and Rows 59-71 with A.

SQUARE V (make 8)

Make same as Square I working Rows 1-12 with A, Rows 13-58 with F, and Rows 59-71 with A.

SQUARE VI (make 8)

Make same as Square I working Rows 1-12 with A, Rows 13-58 with G, and Rows 59-71 with A.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew squares in sets of 4 together to make 12 large squares.

Sew large squares into 3 strips of 4 large squares each, then sew strips together to make Afghan.

Weave in ends.
