Pattern Number: L50050

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 66 x 32 in. (167.5 x 81.5 cm) at widest and longest points

CORRECTIONS: (applied Apr 8, 2015)

SHAWL

Diamond

With A, cast on 160 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K80, place marker (pm), k80.

Row 2: K to last 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1, slip marker (sm), k1, k2tog, k to end of row.

Row 3: Knit.

Rep ~~Row 2~~ **Rows 2 and 3** changing color as follows: work 16 rows with A then 16 rows with B until you have 2 sts remaining.

MATERIALS

- 931-202 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Enchanted Forest

4 Balls (A)

- 931-201 Lion Brand Textures Yarn: Meadow Flowers

2 Balls (B)

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials
Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

**Textures (Article #931). 90% Acrylic, 10% Nylon; package size: 3.00oz/85.05 gr. (149yds/136m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

17 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Shawl is worked in one piece in Garter stitch (knit every row).
2. A center Diamond is worked first, then stitches are picked up across sides of the Diamond to work Right and Left Side Wings.
3. Stitches for the border are picked up along 2 sides of the Shawl.
4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working on straight needles.



SHAWL

Diamond

With A, cast on 160 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K80, place marker (pm), k80.

Row 2: K to last 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1, slip marker (sm), k1, k2tog, k to end of row.

Row 3: Knit.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 changing color as follows: work 16 rows with A then 16 rows with B until you have 2 sts remaining.

Next Row: K2tog.

Fasten off.

Left Side Wing

From RS with A, pick and k80 sts as evenly spaced as possible across left side of Center Square.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 79 sts.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until you have 2 sts remaining.

Next Row (WS): K2tog.

Fasten off.

Right Side Wing

From RS with A, pick up and k80 sts as evenly spaced as possible across right side of Center Square.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (RS): K1, k2tog, k to end of row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until you have 2 sts remaining.

Next Row (WS): K2tog.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Border

From RS with B, pick up and k80 sts as evenly spaced as possible across lower edge of Left Side Wing to Diamond, 80 sts across lower edge of Diamond to lower point of Shawl, pm, pick up and k 80 sts across lower edge of Diamond to Right Side Wing, and 80 sts across lower edge of Right Side Wing – 320 sts.

Row 1: K 160, pm, k to end of row.

Row 2 (RS): K1, kfb, k to 1 st before marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to last st, kfb – 324 sts.

Row 3: Knit, slipping marker as you come to it.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 six more times, then rep Row 2 once more – 352 sts when all increases have been completed.

Bind off.

Weave in ends.
