MATERIALS

- 790-381 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Barley
2 Balls (A)
- 790-311 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Rococo
1 Ball (B)
- 790-309 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Deco
1 Ball (C)
- 790-412 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Pearls
2 Balls (D)
- 790-301 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Shaker
1 Ball (E)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

9 1/2 sts + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in alternating rows of sc and dc.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Afghan is made in one piece, changing yarn color by following written instructions or a chart.
2. All odd-numbered rows are worked in single crochet and all even-numbered rows are worked in double crochet.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Do not fasten off old colors until instructed. Leave colors not in use on WS of piece until next needed.
4. A border is worked around the outside edge of the Afghan.

AFGHAN

First Row of Color Blocks

With E, ch 26; change to D, ch 14; change to C, ch 20; change to B, ch 20; change to A, ch 41 – you will have a total of 121 ch.

Row 1 (RS): With A, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 39 ch; change to B, sc in next 20 ch; change to C, sc in next 20 ch; change to D, sc in next 14 ch; change to E, sc in last 26 ch – you will have 120 sc at the end of Row 1.

Row 2: With E, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 25 sts; change to D, dc in next 14 sts; change to C, dc in next 20 sts; change to B, dc in next 20 sts; change to A, dc in each st to end of row.

Row 3: With A, ch 1, sc in first 40 sts; change to B, sc in next 20 sts; change to C, sc in next 20 sts; change to D, sc in next 14 sts; change to E, sc in each st to end of row, working last sc in top of turning ch.

Rows 4-13: Rep Rows 2 and 3 five more times, continuing to work each color section with color as established.

Row 14: Rep Row 2.

Fasten off all colors.

Change to C.

Second Row of Color Blocks

Row 15 (RS): With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 40 sts; change to D, sc in next 40 sts; change to A, sc in next 26 sts; change to B, sc in each st to end of row, working last sc in top of turning ch.

Row 16: With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 13 sts; change to A, dc in next 26 sts; change to D, dc in next 40 sts; change to C, dc in each st to end of row.

Rows 17-26: Rep Rows 15 and 16 five more times, continuing to work each color section with color as established. Fasten off all colors.

Change to A.

Third Row of Color Blocks

Row 27 (RS): With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first 30 sts; change to B, sc in next 30 sts; change to E, sc in next 34 sts; change to D, sc in each st to end of row, working last sc in top of turning ch.

Row 28: With D, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 25 sts; change to E, dc in next 34 sts; change to B, dc in next 30 sts; change to A, dc in each st to end of row.

Rows 29-40: Rep Rows 27 and 28 six more times, continuing to work each color section with color as established. Fasten off all colors.

Change to B.

Fourth Row of Color Blocks

Row 41 (RS): With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first 20 sts; change to E, sc in next 30 sts; change to D, sc in next 20 sts; change to C, sc in next 24 sts; change to A, sc in each st to end of row, working last sc in top of turning ch.

Row 42: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 25 sts; change to C, dc in next 24 sts; change to D, dc in next 20 sts; change to E, dc in next 30 sts; change to B, dc in each st to end of row.

Rows 43-52: Rep Rows 41 and 42 five more times, continuing to work each color section with color as established. Fasten off all colors.

Change to D.

Fifth Row of Color Blocks

Row 53 (RS): With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first 40 sts; change to A, sc in next 30 sts; change to B, sc in next 18 sts; change to E, sc in next 18 sts; change to C, sc in each st to end of row, working last sc in top of turning ch.

Row 54: With C, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 13 sts; change to E, dc in next 18 sts; change to B, dc in next 18 sts; change to A, dc in next 30 sts; change to D, dc in each st to end of row.

Rows 55-66: Rep Rows 53 and 54 six more times, continuing to work each color section with color as established. Fasten off all colors.

Change to C.

Sixth Row of Color Blocks

Row 67 (RS): With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 26 sts; change to B, sc in next 14 sts; change to D, sc in next 40 sts; change to A, sc in each st to end of row, working last sc in top of turning ch.

Row 68: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 39 sts; change to D, dc in next 40 sts; change to B, dc in next 14 sts; change to C, dc in each st to end of row.

Rows 69-78: Rep Rows 67 and 68 five more times, continuing to work each color section with color as established. Fasten off all colors.

FINISHING

Border

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join D with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of Afghan, ch 1, work sc as evenly spaced as possible around outside edge, working 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, join A with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of Afghan, ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in center sc of each corner 3-sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
