# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Zaps In A Flash Cowl

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**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

### **MATERIALS**

 757-110 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Zaps: Supersonic</u> 2 Balls \*<u>Zaps</u> (Article #757). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (87yds/80m) pull skeins

<u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
 <u>Hook - Size N-13 (9</u>
 <u>mm)</u>

<u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u>
 Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



# **GAUGE:**

10 sts + 5 rounds = 4 in. (10 cm) over Rnds 1-5.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# **NOTES:**

Cowl is worked in one piece in the round.

#### **COWL**

Ch 84.

Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, being careful not to twist ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each ch around.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1), sk next st, \*dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from \* around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – you will have 42 dc and 42 ch-1 sps at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1), \*dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Rep Rnd 3 until piece measures about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from beg.

Last Rnd: Ch 1, sc in each ch-1 sp and dc around; join with sl st in first sc – 84 sts.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
