

#### **MATERIALS**

- 135-099 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Hometown USA Yarn:</u> <u>Los Angeles Tan</u> 10 Balls (A)
- 790-412 <u>Lion Brand</u>
   <u>Homespun Yarn: Pearls</u>

   Balls (B)
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
   <u>Hook Size P-15 (10 mm)</u>
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

\*Hometown USA (Article #135). Solids, Multis, Neons and Team: 100% Acrylic Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Team: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)







#### **GAUGE:**

3 V-sts = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) with 1 strand each of A and B held together.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch


#### STITCH EXPLANATION:


V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated stitch or space.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece with 2 strands of yarn held together.
- 2. Pattern st can be worked by following the written instructions or the diagram.







# **AFGHAN**

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, ch 82.

Row 1: V-st in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and first dc), \*sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – at the end of Row 1, you will have 26 V-sts and 1 dc at beg and end.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, V-st in each ch-1 sp across, dc in top of beg ch. Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 56 in. (142 cm) from beg. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
