 931-204 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Textures Yarn: Ocean</u> <u>Waves</u> 5 Balls *<u>Textures</u> (Article #931). 90% Acrylic, 10% Nylon; package size: 3.00oz/85.05 gr. (149yds/136m) pull skeins



- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of <u>6)</u>

GAUGE:

1 ripple = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm) measured from peak to peak; 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Ripple pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.


NOTES:

1. Three rectangular panels are made then sewn together following a diagram to make the Shawl.

2. Each rectangle is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.

3. The ripple pattern consists of alternating peaks and valleys. Take care to keep the peaks

and valleys of each row aligned. 3 dc are worked into the center 2 dc of peaks and two dc3tog are worked centered over valleys.



SIDE PANELS (make 2)

Ch 57.

Base Row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 56 sc at the end of this row. **Ripple Pattern**

Rows 1-16: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in back loops of next 3 sts, dc3tog twice, dc in back loops of next 3 sts, *3 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in back loops of next 3 sts, dc3tog twice, dc in back loops of next 3 sts; rep from * to turning ch, 3 dc in top of turning ch – 4 ripples. **Last Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

CENTER PANEL

Ch 127.

Base Row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 126 sc at the end of this row. **Ripple Pattern**

Rows 1-21: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in back loops of next 3 sts, dc3tog twice, dc in back loops of next 3 sts, *3 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in back loops of next 3 sts, dc3tog twice, dc in back loops of next 3 sts; rep from * to turning ch, 3 dc in top of turning ch – 9 ripples. **Last Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew last row of each Side Panel to one short edge of Center Panel. Weave in ends.
