Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Fettuccini® Picnic Table Baskets

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SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 28 (34) in. (71 (86.5) cm)

Finished Height About 4 1/2 (6) in. (11.5 (15) cm)

MATERIALS

752-100 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Fettuccini Yarn: Assorted</u>
 1 Ball

 752-200 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Fettuccini Yarn: Solid</u>

1 Ball

<u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook -</u>
 <u>Size P-15 (10 mm)</u>

 <u>Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch</u> Markers

 <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6) *Fettuccini® (Article #752). 100% undetermined fibers - textile by-products ; package size: 11.00oz/312.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

- 1. Baskets are worked in the round, handles are worked directly onto Baskets.
- 2. One ball of yarn makes one Basket.
- 3. Yarn thickness in each ball varies slightly so your Basket may be a bit larger or smaller than our sample.

SMALL BASKET

With either yarn, ch 11.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 8 ch, 4 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 8 ch, 2 sc in next ch; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 24 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, sc in last 2 sts; join with sl st in first sc - 32 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each st around; do not join, beg working in continuous rnds (spiral). Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd.

Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 5: Working in back loops only, sc in each st around.

Rnd 6: Working in back loops only, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 2 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 36 sts. Fasten off.

Handles

Mark center st at each narrow end of Basket.

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in 2nd sc before marked center st at one end.

Ch 7, sk next 3 sc along edge of Basket, sl st in next st.

Fasten off.

Rep to make handle at opposite end of Basket, but do not fasten off.

Edging Rnd: *Sc in each st around to ch-7 handle, sl st in each of the 7 ch; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

LARGE BASKET

With either yarn, ch 11.

Rnds 1-3: Work same as Rnds 1-3 of Small Basket - 32 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc in last st; join with sl st in first sc – 40 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each st around; do not join, beg working in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd.

Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 6: Working in back loops only, sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: Working in back loops only, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st

Rnds 8 and 9: Working in back loops only, sc in each st around.

At end of Rnd 9; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Handles

Mark center st at each narrow end of Basket.

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in 3rd sc before marked center st at one end.

Ch 10, sk next 6 sc along edge of Basket, sl st in next st.

Fasten off.

Rep to make handle at opposite end of Basket, but do not fasten off.

Edging Rnd: *Sc in each st around to ch-10 handle, sl st in each of the 10 ch; rep from * around, join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
